A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT TO CONCH REPUBLIC SEAFOOD COMPANY TO CONDUCT THE FLORIDA POWERBOAT CLUB'S 33RD ANNUAL POKER RUN VILLAGE AT THE 631 GREENE STREET PARKING LOT AND ADJACENT GRAVEL LOT ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2025, THROUGH SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2025 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M.; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2025, THROUGH SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2025; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Conch Republic Seafood Company has applied to the city for a Special Event Permit for their event "Florida Powerboat Club's 33rd Annual Poker Run Village" to take place on Wednesday, November 5, 2025, through Sunday, November 9, 2025, from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, amplified sound from a speaker for awards and announcements will be played during the event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary

vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.

SECTION 3. That Conch Republic Seafood Company. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the place and time as herein described above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That Conch Republic Seafood will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That Conch Republic Seafood acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department, Community Services and any other costs

required under the City's Special Events Ordinance, and in compliance with all rules and regulations governing special events.

SECTION 6. That Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 7.}}$ There will be amplified sound from a speaker for announcements and awards during the event.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
