### **Tab 4: Project Approach**

Operations Plan:

- D2C Vends will be responsible for the procurement, placement, operation, maintenance inventory/stocking, and financial reporting for food, drink, and recreational/sports related items on various City of Key West owned or leased properties. Initially 12 locations have been identified in this RFP with specific City needs specified for each location, however there is potential to grow as this project moves forward. D2C Vends anticipates meeting

all contract additions with enthusiasm. The initial locations are excellent high traffic areas ensured to be successful.

- Each Machine will be restocked at a minimum of twice/ week. Utilizing modern remote monitoring technology incorporated in each machine, inventory will be tracked remotely with software intended for this exact purpose to ensure machines are always sufficiently stocked and available to provide service to the public. In addition to inventory the software detects when there is an error in the machine, such as an Item not dispensing, temperatures out of parameters, payment methods not functioning etc. Maintenance response times will be prompt same day to initially diagnose issues that arise. Common failure points have been researched and replacement parts will be in stock to solve most issues promptly.
- Staffing will be assessed upon award of contract. At a minimum 1 backup employee will be maintained to stock/maintain machines in absence of primary. Providing primarily nonperishable items allow ample inventory to be kept, if supply chain issues arrive, D2C will utilize several months of inventory while a solution is sought. In case of supply chain disruptions, it may be necessary to adjust options temporarily to ensure quality products are being distributed.
- A proposed product selection is enclosed in this proposal as Enclosure (2). It includes a large variety of products meant to serve the different clientele anticipated at each location. D2C Vends is fully adaptable and anticipates product adjustment to best meet the needs of the locations served. Sports and recreational items will be offered in the areas which serve athletic/recreational activities. Healthy options will be incorporated from the beginning and adapted as demand dictates.
- D2C Vends will utilize NAYAX Point of Sale Systems to enable credit/debit cards, and apple/android/google pay to make items available to a broad customer base. Each machine will incorporate remote monitoring software to streamline operations and financial reporting.

#### Project Management:

- All communications with the City of Key West will be through the main POC Cory Tomasetti via phone call/text/email/mail based on the most effective method as dictated by the type of communication.
- D2C Vends will utilize various Makes/Models of Vending Machines to meet the requirements of the contract. Machine type and construction will be selected based on the specific environment the machine will be placed in. Factors which impact selection are indoor/outdoor, covered/uncovered, proximity to saltwater, humidity and product type. Due to the extreme temperatures Key West experiences in the summer any outdoor snack machine will need to be refrigerated regardless of contents. Exact machine selection will be determined following the site visits w/ the city representative upon award of contract. All machines are Energy Star Certified for

efficiency, utilizing variable speed compressors, LED lighting, and smart sensors and timers to conserve energy consumption. Machines are all ADA compliant, ensuring access to all potential customers. Additionally all machines utilize HC R-290 refrigerant ensuring these machines make minimal environmental impact even in the case of total failure.

- Quality Assurance: To ensue the highest quality in its service and products D2C Vends will relentlessly ensure the highest standards are met and exceeded continuously. Processes will include precise tracking of expiration dates of inventory upon purchase ensuring items nearing expiration are removed in advance of expiring. Cleanings of machines at each restocking (minimum 2x/week) with food safe disinfectants.
- Subcontractor Documentation: No subcontractors will be utilized.

- D2C Vends has the ability to print in house custom vinyl wraps. This will be utilized to visually enhance each machine with graphics fitting to the specific location. This allows the machines to flow with the environment and limit the aesthetic contrast to many of Key Wests historic and beautiful facilities compared to the typical corporate branded machines.
- D2C Vends Owner has lived in Key West for 3 years since being stationed here in the military. Owner is transitioning out of the military and establishing a business with strong community ties. I frequent many of the included locations and utilize many of the recreational facilities and would love the opportunity to become a part of this community and contribute something positive to foster positive experiences for locals and tourists!
- The contract with the City of Key West resulting from this proposal will initially be the only contract for this business. This will allow the company to exclusively focus and grow specifically around the needs of the city and its needs.
