On Wednesday, 08/09/23, at approximately 0318hrs, Sgt. K. Malsheimer, Ofc. F. Moore and I (Ofc. T. Clark), responded to 1445 S. Roosevelt Blvd, Coconut Mallory Bar, in reference to a battery that had just occurred.

While enroute to the call KWPD Dispatch advised the victim, Brandy Gesell was reporting her boyfriend hitting her at the location. We knew from previous interactions, the boyfriend William David Jennings 07/21/23, had an active warrant for his arrest from Key West Police Department, after fleeing a uniformed officer, in a previous investigation (KWPD 23-4339).

BWC and In car camera activated

****IMPORTANT TO NOTE ALL RESPONDING OFFICERS WERE IN FULL KWPD UNIFORM, WITH BADGE DISPLAYED AND IN MARKED PATROL VEHICLES****

Sgt. Malsheimer and Ofc. Moore arrived on scene first (see supplemental reports) and were flagged down by Brandy who was actively pointing at William. Sgt Malsheimer saw William who fled from him. Sgt Malsheimer issued loud boisterous commands for William to stop and identified himself as KWPD. William looked at Sgt. Malsheimer and continued flee after receiving lawful commands to stop. William chose to actively resist arrest and continue fleeing(William later admitted to knowledge of his warrant).

Sgt. Malsheimer had no other recourse but deploy his department issued Taser. The Taser failed to achieve neuro-muscular incapacitation and William jumped a fence on the property and continued to run away. Sgt. Malsheimer continued to chase William westbound through the property. William attempted to climb a fence but failed as Sgt. Malsheimer closed the distance between them. Sgt. Malsheimer applied a drive-stun cycle to William and William went to the ground. Officer Moore handcuffed William.

Search Incident to arrest, a glass methamphetamine pipe was located on his person (FTP Sgt. Malsheimer). William was cleared by EMS reference being Tased. Sgt. N. Revoredo responded to the scene. KWFD responded to treat Williams minor visible injuries from being Tased.

KWPD Dispatch later confirmed the warrant for Williams arrest.

I met with the victim, Brandy and a third party witness, Michael Paler 09/10/64 (FL DL).

Paler stated the following: He was at the bar speaking with Brandy. It was closing time at the bar. William entered the bar and began asking weird questions and had a strange demeanor. William asked what they were doing together. Paler decided to leave. Paler exited the bar, heard a strange sound and turned around to see William shove Brandy and slap her in the face.

Brandy stated the following: She has been in a eight month ongoing sexual relationship with William. William has a drug problem. She invited William to the bar because she want to help him. William came to the bar and was upset. William poked her in her face and slapped her.

I could see visible swelling to Brandy's left eyebrow. I photographed the visible injury and uploaded to AXON. KWFD responded and she refused treatment.

Brandy was unsure on pressing charges and was crying. I issued Brandy a Victim's Right's Brochure and KWPD case number. Brandy advised she would contact KWPD tomorrow for video footage of this incident.

REPORTING OFFICER NARRATIVE

Key West Police Department

I approached William who was under arrest. I read him his Miranda Warning's from a prepared card. William wished to speak with me. William did not admit to slapping or shoving Brandy. William did say he was poking her in the face over the bar. William also said they were in an ongoing sexual relationship.

I transported Williams to jail.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge William with the following:

One count, FSS 843.02, Resisting Without Violence, William did flee arrest and investigation, after lawful orders to stop, from a uniformed KWPD Officer.

One count, FSS 784.03(1)(a)(1), Battery, Dating Violence, William did commit a battery against his on-going sexual dating partner Brandy. This was of own self admittance, third party witness and visible injury corroborating statements.

One count, FSS 893.147(1), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, William did have in possession a FTP Methamphetamine smoking pipe, located in his pocket, search incident to arrest.

On August 9, 2023, at approximately 0314 hours, I (Sergeant Malsheimer) responded to a battery call at Coconut Mallory (1445 South Roosevelt Boulevard). Prior to my arrival, KWPD Dispatch noted in the CAD call that the suspect was named William Jennings. I was familiar with Jennings from a previous incident on July 30, 2023, where he fled from KWPD officers. I was also aware that Officer James Young obtained an arrest warrant for Jennings that was still active.

Upon my arrival near the central area of Coconut Mallory I observed a female (Brandy Gesell) frantically pointing in the southwest direction, as if to direct me to Jennings' location. I exited my patrol vehicle and ran towards the area. I observed Jennings as he looked at me while running in the opposite direction. I was dressed in my KWPD Class B uniform and clearly identifiable as law enforcement. I verbally identified myself as Key West Police and gave loud verbal commands to Jennings to stop. Jennings continued to run southwards toward the pool area and began jumping an approximately 4 foot tall fence. I drew and deployed my TASER, striking Jennings but failing to obtain neuro-muscular incapacitation. Jennings continued to run away from me with at least 1 TASER probe embedded in his skin. This was evidence as the TASER electrical wire was being carried with Jennings as he ran away. I deployed my TASER towards Jennings again, but am uncertain if either probe struck him.

I opened the gate Jennings had jumped and continued chasing him on foot, westward through the pool/patio area of Coconut Mallory. Jennings reached a fence of a substantial height and attempted to climb it without success. Jennings then turned around and came back towards my direction. My TASER was still displayed while I approached Jennings. I ordered Jennings to go to the ground and lay on his stomach. Jennings went to the ground but did not go to his stomach. I applied a single cycle of drive-stun with my TASER to Jennings' abdominal area. Jennings immediately responded to the effects of the drive-stun by flipping onto his stomach and putting his hands behind his back as I had already been ordering him to do. Officer Moore who had been some distance behind me in the chase had arrived and placed Jennings into handcuffs.

I removed a single TASER probe from the left hip/shorts Jennings was wearing. Officer Moore called for Key West Rescue to respond for an evaluation of Jennings. Jennings was sweating profusely and breathing heavily. I assisted Jennings in standing up and escorted him to the front of Officer Moore's transport van. I searched Jennings. In Jennings' right pocket I discovered a clear glass smoking pipe with burnt residue as well as a white powdery residue inside it. I later field tested the white powder and it field tested positive (FTP) for methamphetamine. Jennings made the statement, "that's fucking hers" and said he found it in the women's restroom. Jennings had a small torch burner in his left pocket. Jennings was escorted into the transport van.

Sergeant Revoredo and Officer Clark responded to the scene. I informed them of what happened. I placed the glass pipe with FTP methamphetamine residue and the expended TASER cartridges into the KWPD Property & Evidence

On Wednesday, August 9, 2023, at approximately 0315 hours, I, Ofc. F. Moore, was dispatched to Coconut Malory Resort Marina located at 1445 South Roosevelt Boulevard for a battery call.

Upon arrival, Sgt. Malsheimer and I immediately engaged in a foot pursuit for the male subject, later identified as William David Jennings (DOB 07/21/1984), into the south side pool area of the resort. I was behind Sgt. Malsheimer in the foot pursuit. While in foot pursuit I heard Sgt. Malsheimer shout commands to Jennings to stop or he would be tased. I then heard a taser being fired and Sgt. Malsheimer yelling at Jennings to stop and get on the ground. When I caught up with Sgt. Malsheimer, he was giving Jennings commands to get on his stomach. I immediately placed Jennings in handcuffs while he was in the prone position. Once Jennings was secured, I informed Key West Police Dispatch to send rescue to give medical attention to Jennings who had been struck by a taser probe.

Sgt. Malsheimer removed the taser probe from the waist on Jennings left side. Sgt. Malsheimer and I then helped Jennings to his feet, and I collected the taser probes and secured them. Sgt. Malsheimer and I then escorted Jennigs to the Key West Police Transport Van that I was driving. Jennings was searched and then placed in the back of the Key West Police transport van without further incident.

Jennings was later transferred from the Key West Police transport van to Ofc. Clark's Key West Police marked patrol vehicle and transported to the Monroe County Detention Center.

My Axon Body Worn Camera was active for the encounter. All video was uploaded to Evidence.com.
