A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$81,496.01 FOR MILLING, PAVING AND STRIPING OF THE SIMONTON BEACH PARKING LOT; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 21-125, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities and Infrastructure Services contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of a Task Order to mill, pave and stripe the Simonton Street Beach Parking Lot to improve safety and appearance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order under the City's General Utilities and Infrastructure Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total amount not to exceed \$81,496.01, for milling, paving and striping the Simonton Street Beach Parking Lot, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funding is budgeted for the parking lot improvements in Infrastructure Surtax/Parks and Recreation/Infrastructure account 101-7201-572-6300. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents for this project, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
