Subject: **24-5792 Award of Design Contract to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for Fogarty and 3rd Streets Stormwater Improvements Project**

Introduction

Approval of the resolution will award a contract to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. (Jacobs) in the amount of \$698,341.70 for the design and permitting of the Fogarty and 3rd Streets Stormwater Improvements Project. The resolution will authorize the City Manager to execute the contract upon consent of the City Attorney and approve any necessary budget transfers.

Background

The main project purpose is to design drainage system improvements for the neighborhood that will remain viable under future climate changes. The project scope of improvements will include stormwater infrastructure consisting of drainage pipes, inlets, an emergency ocean outfall, and road restoration. Additionally, the piping, inlets, and emergency outfall will be sized to accommodate a future stormwater pump station which will be located and conceptually designed under this Task Order that can be implemented at a future date when the proposed gravity system is no longer viable under projected sea level rise conditions.

Per Resolution 23-334, the City Commission approved the staff rankings for RFQ 23-007, "Fogarty & 3rd St. Pump Assisted Injection Well Stormwater Utility Design Services" and authorized the City Manager to enter contract negotiations with the top ranked firm, Jacobs. Staff received a proposed scope of work and fee from Jacobs and subsequently reviewed the proposal for consistency with the intent of the RFQ and conformance with staff's expectation of level of effort. Jacobs has adequately addressed staff's comments and the fee of \$698,341.70 is appropriate for the level of effort for this project.

Procurement

Per Resolution 22-211, City Commission approved the “State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity Federally Funded Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT) Subrecipient Agreement” Number MT050 for the Fogarty and 3rd Pump Assist Injection Well Project in the amount of up to \$6,336,165.00, plus City matching funds of up to \$1,206,900.00, for design and construction.

This project is budgeted to a maximum reimbursement amount of \$6,336,165.00 in grant revenue to account 402-0000-331-3600 (Stormwater Utility/Revenue/Stormwater Grant), and expense account 402-3802-538-6500 (Stormwater Utility/Construction/Construction In Progress), Project ST38022201 – Fogarty and 3rd Pump Assist Injection Well Project. The CDBG-MIT agreement No. MT050 has been executed and reimbursement will be requested as work progresses.

Recommendation

Staff recommends awarding the contract for the Fogarty and 3rd Streets Stormwater Improvements Project to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. and authorize the City Manager to execute the contact upon consent of the City Attorney and approve any necessary budget transfers.
