## Approval to award ITB 12-023: Navy Mole Pier Electrical

 SUBJECT: Distribution System Upgrades to Florida Keys Electric Inc and approval of a budget amendment.
## ACTION STATEMENT:

Invitation to Bid 12-023 was advertised on 2 May, 2012 and bids were opened on 17 May 2012. Six bids were received with the Florida Keys Electric, Inc in the amount of $\$ 1,223,025.10$ dollars. A part of this approval is to move funds from Navy Reserves Account \#602-1900-519-9800 to Navy Repairs and Maintenance Account \#602-1900-519-4600.

## BACKGROUND:

In lieu of rent payments to the Navy for the use of the Mole pier, the CITY has agreed to perform certain In-Kind Projects. ITB 12-023: Navy Mole Pier Electrical Distribution System Upgrades was requested by the Navy as indicated in Attachment 1.

## PURPOSE \& JUSTIFICATION:

Repairs to the Mole Pier Electrical Distribution system is a critical project needed to support the Navy and the upcoming UNITAS EXERCISE schedule for the first week of September 2012.

## OPTIONS:

1. City Commission can approve this award of this contract to Florida Keys Electric Inc in the amount of $\$ 1,233,025.10$ dollars
2. City Commission could elect to reject all bids and cancel this project
3. City Commission can reject all bids and direct staff to re-bid the project.

## FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Budget Amendment: Funds in the amount of the lowest bid will be moved from the Navy Reserves Account \#602-1900-519-9800 to Navy Repairs and Maintenance Account \#602-1900-519-4600 and used to fund this project.

## RECOMMENDATION:

City Staff recommends that the City Commission approve option 1 and award this project to Florida Keys Electric Inc.
