### **Introduction**

The City Manager’s Office requests the approval of the “Tats for TaTas” fundraiser on Wednesday, October 14, 2026, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Greene Street between Ann Street and Simonton Street.

### **Background**

The City Manager’s Office has received an application from Womankind, Inc. for the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Tats for TaTas fundraiser on Wednesday, October 14, 2026. Greene Street will be closed between Ann Street and Simonton Street. Setup will begin at 9:00 a.m. and breakdown will be completed by 11:00 p.m. The main event will be inside Tattoos & Scars Saloon and on their property. Alcohol sales will be on Tattoos & Scars Saloon property under their existing liquor license, with a satellite bar on Greene Street. Womankind is requesting the partial closure of Greene Street to put up a large tent. Tables and chairs for a silent auction and a small DJ booth will be set up underneath the tent. A stage will be set up for MC and announcements and this year it will be set up outside to allow for more room inside Tattoos & Scars Saloon. There will be spaces for food truck vendors, a satellite bar and other potential vendors with tents. Proceeds benefit Womankind, Inc. to supplement healthcare costs to women, men and teens. The applicant has agreed to abide by City Codes and Ordinances, including providing insurance.

The applicant is requesting approval for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

Due to having amplified music, a noise exemption is requested. Notice of the City Commission's proposed action on a Noise Exemption was published in The Citizen and on KeysNews.com. Property owners within a 100-foot radius were mailed notice.

### **Procurement**

There will be no additional expenses to the city as all service costs (Police/Fire/Community Services) are covered by the applicant, based on the Special Event Matrix.

### **Recommendation**

The City Manager's Office recommends the Mayor and Commission approve the "Tats for TaTas" on Wednesday, October 14, 2026, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Greene Street between Ann and Simonton Streets.
