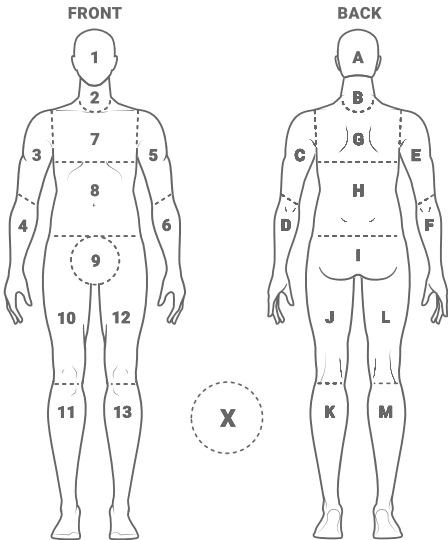

EXPLANATION OF RESISTANCE LEVEL		
<p>The subject displayed active physical resistance: he made physically evasive movements to defeat an officers attempt at control. Subject John Doe pulled away from Ofc Brablc 3 to 4 times and also tried to walk away.</p> <p>Ofc Brablc responded by using Physical Control- achieving compliance or custody thru the use of empty hand or leverage enhanced techniques, such as takedowns. Take Downs- techniques that redirect, in a controlled manner, a person to the ground to limit his physical resistance and to apply handcuffs. Ofc Brablc used an Arm Drag takedown to gain compliance, redirecting the subject to the ground in a controlled manner. After doing so, Ofc Brablc was able to properly apply handcuffs.</p>		

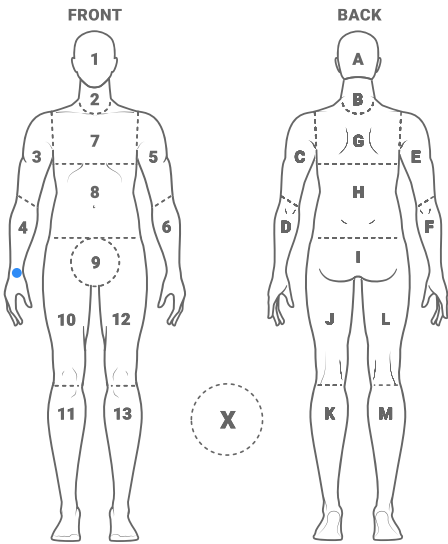

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

Ofc Brabc, earlier in the day, had responded to Tattoos and Scars, in reference to a black male subject trespassing and committing acts of vandalism. When officers checked the immediate area, they were not able to locate the male. Some time later, Ofc Brabc located the male at Simonton Beach

and made contact with him. Ofc Brabc said the male did not want to speak with him, and that he turned around to walk away. Ofc Brabc said he told the male he was under arrest and to comply with his orders. Ofc Brabc is sure he grabbed the subjects right wrist, as he attempted to turn and walk away. Ofc Brabc said the male tried 3 to 4 times to pull his arm away. At this time, Ofc Brabc did an arm drag takedown, and redirected the male to the ground, where he handcuffed him.

There were no injuries to Ofc Brabc or the subject. The male had no complaints when I spoke with him. He was not forthcoming with information. At the time of this report he has not been identified.
