A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A 2016-2017 HIGH VISIBILITY PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY ENFORCEMENT (HVE) FUNDING GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) VIA A CONTRACT ADMINISTERED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA'S CENTER FOR URBAN TRANSPORTATION RESEARCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,852.36; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached FDOT HVE High Visibility Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Enforcement Funding grant via a contract administered by University of South Florida's Center for Urban Transportation Research, in the amount of \$28,852.36, is hereby accepted for use by the Key West Police Department.

Section 2: That budget amendments to reflect receipt and allocation of the grant are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney, on behalf of the Key West Police Department.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
