WHEREAS, Key West Botanical Garden is globally recognized for its efforts in environmental protection and as a premier conservation site for native flora and fauna in the region; and


WHEREAS, Key West Botanical Garden curates over 565 species of native plants representing the Florida Keys, Cuba, and the Caribbean.
