Photos that were obtained by City Marine Port Services Tim Tychand and Jiaro Huete Alverez were also shown to the court. Jiaro Huete Alverez accompanied by Code Officer Paul Navarro for translation confirmed that he took those photos and saw the violation first hand. The Special Magistrate thought that there was substantial evidence for a finding of violation and imposed \$250.00 administrative cost and \$122.00 for clean up costs. Also imposed was \$5,000.00 per two irreparable counts for a total of \$10,372.00 and payment shall be received by 5 July 2024 by 5:00PM.
