**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING KEY WEST BUSINESS GUILD, INC. TO CONDUCT A PRIDE STREET FAIR ON SATURDAY JUNE 10, 2023 FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M. (SET UP AT 7:00 AM) ON THE 600, 700, 800 & 900 BLOCKS OF DUVAL STREET AND THE KEY WEST PRIDE PARADE ON SUNDAY, JUNE 11, 2023 FROM 5:00 P.M. TO 8:30 P.M STAGING AT THE QUAY WALL AT THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the Key West Business Guild, Inc. wishes to conduct their annual 2023 Pride Fest Celebration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

**SECTION 1.** That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law”

**SECTION 2.** “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable.

Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.”

**SECTION 3.** That the Key West Business Guild, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct a street closure on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

**SECTION 4.** That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Key West Business Guild, Inc. is hereby granted permission to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

**SECTION 5.** That the Key West Business Guild, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

**SECTION 6.** That the Key West Business Guild, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

**SECTION 7.** That the Key West Business Guild, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the closure of 600, 700, 800 & 900 blocks of Duval Street for a street fair and the Quay Wall for the lineup of the Pride Parade.

**SECTION 8.** That the Key West Business Guild, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West and that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 9.** This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
