On Thursday, August 27, 2020, at 1917 hours, Officer Purcell and I (Officer Morris) were dispatched to 3145 Flagler Ave (Blake Fernandez Skate Park) reference an assault. The reporting party, Bernard Simmons, said another male at the park threatened to slap him.

Upon arrival, Officer Purcell and I approached the entrance of the skate park and heard a loud argument. As we walked around the building, we saw a skinny black male who was standing near the entrance of the skate park. The male was yelling and cursing. Another larger black male, later identified as Ralph Major, was trying to get the other male to calm down. Major is an employee of the City of Key West. The smaller male walked toward Major in an aggressive manner. Ralph advised us that the other male needed to leave because he was causing a disturbance. The other male said he was trying to leave and continued cursing and screaming. I explained to the male that he was not free to leave because we were conducting an investigation. The male who had gathered his belongings and was about to get onto his bicycle, dropped his bicycle and started asking everyone in the skate park if he was bothering anyone. I was currently standing in the walkway to the skatepark and the male pushed past me to continue to ask the people in the skatepark if he was bothering anyone. I placed my hand out and the male walked into my hand. When the male's chest touched my hand, the male slapped the top of my left hand and yelled, "don't touch me." The male turned around and continued to gather his belongings. Officer Purcell and I continued to explain to the male that he was not allowed to leave. I explained to the male that he needed to talk to us and explain what happened. The male asked why he needed to talk to us? The male then pointed to Simmons and called him "a bitch ass nigga." The male then said Simmons asked him to move his bicycle and not to smoke a cigarette. The male said he complied as he continued gathering his belongings. The male then yelled, "its always a nigga fucking with a nigga." The male continued to harass Simmons with Officer Purcell and I standing right in front of him. Officer Purcell pleaded with the man asking for him to stop screaming and cussing in front of the kids who were standing 20 feet away witnessing the entire incident. The male then told Simmons that Simmons had the police trying to beat him up. Officer Purcell and I were showing no signs of aggression and pleading with the male to calm down. The male said he was leaving, and I explained to him that he was not allowed to leave because we were trying to figure out what was going on. I asked the male to stop cursing and screaming as he said "a nigga just threw me out the park for no reason." I told the male that I didn't even know his name. The male started screaming and threw his bicycle on the ground. The male threw objects that were in his hands at the fence and continued cussing and yelling. The male walked away from officer Purcell as he was throwing the objects. The male then turned back toward Officer Purcell and I, flexing his arms and chest muscles and screamed very loudly. The male continued to approach us as Officer Purcell and I asked him to relax. The male approached me as he was repeatedly yelling, "I ain't did shit." I told the male to get back and he turned and kicked a beer can that was lying on the ground, toward Major who was standing off to the side. The male turned back around and picked his bicycle up. I told Officer Purcell that we were going to place the male into custody reference Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer and Disorderly Conduct. Officer Purcell and I approached the male and the male turned around swiftly. The male pushed Officer Purcell backward and squared up in a fighting stance toward Officer Purcell, offering violence and told Officer Purcell to, "get the fuck off of me." Officer Purcell again approached the male. The male punched Officer Purcell with a closed fist in the left side of Officer Purcell's face, knocking Officer Purcell to his knees. The male tried to punch Officer Purcell a second time but missed. The male continued to approach Officer Purcell offering to do further violence. I drew my Key West Police Department Issued TASER and deployed it. The TASER prongs contacted the individual on the left side of his body but did not achieve Neuromuscular Incapacitation (MNI). Officer Purcell regained his balance and stood up to his feet. The male squared up to Officer Purcell again and Officer Purcell pushed the individual into a nearby fence, knocking him to the ground. The male continued to resist by trying to punch Officer Purcell. I reevaluated the situation and I placed the TASER to the individuals leg and cycled my TASER again telling the male to roll onto his stomach, this time achieving NMI. Officer Purcell placed the male into handcuffs.

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Officer T. Anglin arrived on scene and we escorted the male to my patrol vehicle. Key West Fire Rescue responded to the scene and treated the male for his injuries.

I spoke with Simmons who said the male came to the park with an open container of what he knew to be alcohol. Simmons said the male brought his bicycle into an area where bicycles were not allowed and pulled out a cigarette which also was not allowed at the park. Simmons said he asked the male to throw away the beer, put his bicycle in the bike rack, and Simmons told the male he could not smoke. Simmons said the male became irate and threatened to slap him. Simmons said the male left the area with his belongings but left his cell phone behind. Simmons said he went into the office and called the police. Simmons said the male returned and started threatening him further. Simmons said his boss, Ralph Major, arrived and tried to calm the man. Simmons said at that time the police arrived. As Simmons was talking with me, he was crying and obviously very scared and upset over the entire incident.

I spoke with kids who were in the area that witnessed the incident. the kids showed me video footage of the incident. the video shows the male waling around the front entrance to the park, yelling and cussing. The video then shows the male open the office door and start to enter the office. The male continues yelling and cussing at Simmons, who at this time is sitting inside the office. Another video shows Major arrive and ask the male to stop yelling and cussing. The male then pushes Major backward and continues yelling and cussing.

Sgt. Vazquez responded to the scene and completed a RRI.

While interacting with the male, the unknown object that he threw was later identified as a large Four Loko beer. The contents of the beer were thrown onto the ground by Young during his rage. The contents were frothy and smelled of an alcoholic beverage.

The male identified himself as Abram Lewis Young, DOB 12/10/1978. I transported Young to the Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.

I removed the prongs from the TASER which were located in Youngs stomach and back and placed them back into the cartridge.

Arrest information:

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 8/27/2020, at 1917 hours, Abram Lewis Young, did knowingly open the exterior door to the office of the skatepark and attempt to enter with the intentions to threaten and inflict fear in Bernard Simmons by making threats to do violence toward Simmons. Thus violating F.S.S. 810.02-2A BURGLARY-WITH ASSAULT OR BATTERY.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 8/27/2020, at 1917 hours, Abram Lewis Young, did knowingly strike my hand and punch Officer Purcell in the face while both myself and Officer Purcell were conducting a criminal investigation. Thus violating two counts of F.S.S. 784.07-2B BATTERY ON LEO.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 8/27/2020, at 1917 hours, Abram Lewis Young, did knowingly push Ralph Major against his will thus violating F.S.S. BATTERY; TOUCH OR STRIKE.

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Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 8/27/2020, at 1917 hours, Abram Lewis Young, did knowingly affect the peace and quiet of persons around him by yelling and cursing numerous times in the presence of children who were only approximately 15-20 feet away from him, in violation of F.S.S. 877.03 DISORDERLY CONDUCT.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 8/27/2020, at 1917 hours, Abram Lewis Young, did knowingly offer to do violence to myself and Officer Purcell by clenching his fists and squaring his body up to us, in violation of F.S.S. 843.01 RESIST OFFICER WITH VIOLENCE.

Based on the facts and evidence, there is probable cause that on 8/27/2020, at 1917 hours, Abram Lewis Young, did knowingly have an open container of alcohol in a city park in violation of MOV 26-97 OPEN CONTAINER IN PARK.

The incident was captured on my AXON BWC and in car COBAN.

Officer Purcell placed Young's property into Key West Police Department and Evidence division. Officer Purcell also placed the TASER cartridge and AFIDS into KWPD Property and Evidence.

On 8/27/2020 at approximately 1920 hours, Officer Morris and I, Officer Purcell, responded to 3145 Flagler Ave (the skate park) in reference to a potential assault.

Upon our arrival I observed a black male (later identified as Abram Young) yelling profanities at city employee. Officer Morris and I gave Young multiple verbal commands to calm down and stop yelling. Young told us he was leaving and grabbed his bike. Officer Morris and I informed Young he was not leaving until we figured out what was going on. Young threw his bike and began to yell and wave his arms in an erratic manner. I attempted to grab Young's left arm to place him in handcuffs. Young pulled away from me and struck me behind the left ear with his right fist. I went to a knee and blocked a second punch with my left forearm. I stood and struck the left side of Young's head with my right fist. Simultaneously Officer Morris deployed his taser striking him in the side and the back with the probes. I pushed Young onto the ground and placed him in handcuffs.

I packaged and submitted Officer Morris's taser cartridge and taser AFIDs and placed them in the Key West Police Department Property and Evidence. I also labeled Young's bike and bag of personal belongings and placed them in the bike cage.

My Axon BWC was activated for this investigation.
