NOTICE OF HEARING TO RE-IMPOSE AND PROVIDE FOR COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE SERVICE SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

Notice is hereby given that the City of Key West, will conduct a public hearing to consider re-imposing solid waste service assessments for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018, against certain improved residential properties located within the incorporated area of the City, to fund the cost of solid waste collection and disposal services, facilities and programs provided to such properties and to authorize collection of such assessments on the tax bill.

The public hearing will be held at a Special City Commission meeting at 6:00 p.m. on August 21, 2018, City Hall, 1300 White St, Key West, Florida, for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposed assessments. All affected property owners have a right to appear at the hearing and to file written objections with the City Commission within 20 calendar days of the date of this notice. If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at the hearing, such person will need a record of the proceedings and may need to ensure that a verbatim record is made, including the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be made. It is the policy of the City of Key West to comply with all requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Please call the TTY number at 1-800-955-8771 or for voice 1-800-955-8770 or the ADA Coordinator at 305-609-0611 at least five business days in advance for sign language interpreters, assistive listening devices, or materials in accessible format.

The rate of assessment for Fiscal Year 2018-19 shall be \$305.63 per dwelling unit for solid waste services. The maximum rate of assessment for future fiscal years shall be \$393.08 per dwelling unit for solid waste services.

The total annual solid waste assessment revenue to be collected within the City is estimated to be \$4,280,614. Copies of the Solid Waste Service Assessment Ordinance (Ordinance No.13-09), the Preliminary Rate Resolution initiating the annual process of updating the Assessment Roll and re-imposing the Solid Waste Service Assessments, and the updated Assessment Roll for the upcoming fiscal year are available for inspection at the City Clerk's office, located at 1300 White St., Key West, Florida.

The assessments will be collected on the ad valorem tax bill to be mailed in November 2018, as authorized by section 187.3637, Florida Statutes. Failure to pay the assessments will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property which may result in a loss of title.
