WHEREAS, the ship's motto "Launch the Attack" is the succinct but powerful order Admiral Spruance issued to his staff when the first of four Japanese aircraft carriers were located on the morning of the Battle of Midway on 4 June 1942; and

WHEREAS, the men and women of the USS SPRUANCE (DDG 111) proudly represent the core values of honor, courage, and commitment of the United States Navy, and will be forever welcome in Key West, the Southernmost City in the Continental United States and home of the Conch Republic,
