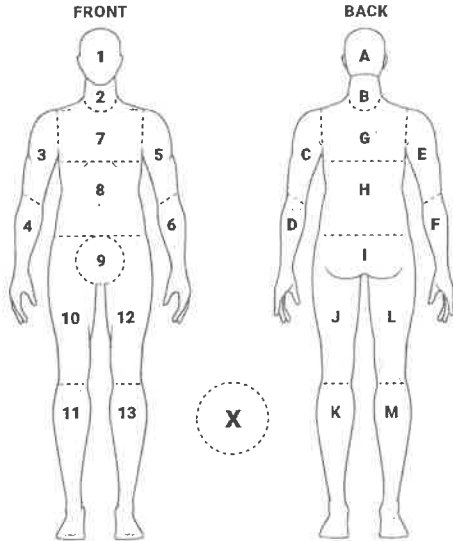

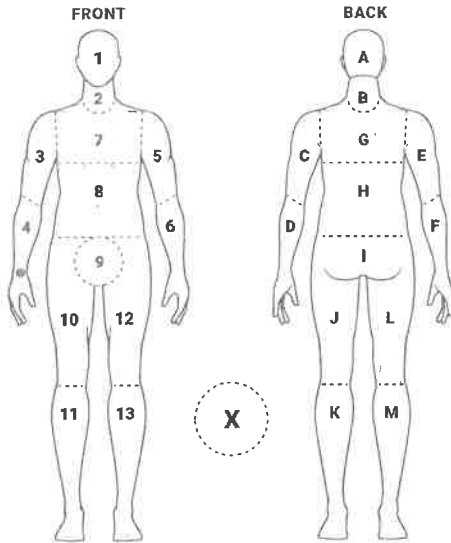

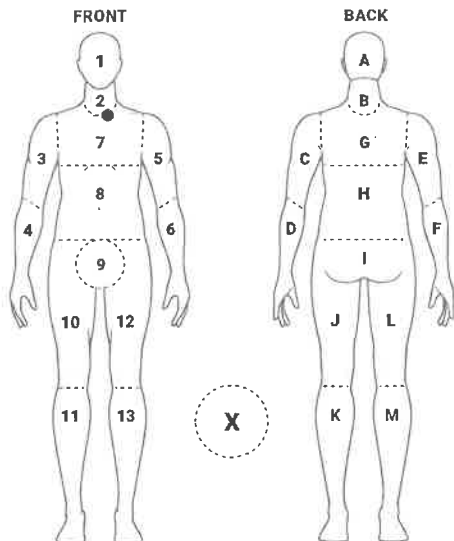

call for assistance from an MCSO Deputy trying to stop a subject who was wandering the traffic lanes. The MCSO Deputy advised he had attempted to get the person, later identified as Conner Cannon, to exit the roadway, but his commands were being ignored.

Sgt. Siracuse arrived on scene first to assist. When I arrived, observed Cannon on the ground, actively resisting being handcuffed by Sgt. Siracuse and Deputy Lane. I observed Cannon was the same subject of a previous complaint.

Once Cannon was handcuffed, I placed him in the rear of my patrol vehicle. I asked Sgt. Siracuse what happened. Sgt. Siracuse relayed the following information:

On 8/4/24, at approximately 1000 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to a call on the 3200 block of N. Roosevelt Blvd, reference a white male walking shirtless down the middle of roadway. This was the second time we responded to deal with the subject, later identified as Conner Cannon (7/23/92). During this incident, MCSO Deputy Lane came across KWPD channel one requesting help saying he was attempting to stop Cannon, but he was ignoring his commands and remained walking away from him in the roadway. Upon arrival, Cannon was walking toward my vehicle (westbound) with Deputy Lane following in a MCSO marked patrol vehicle with emergency lights activated. I stopped and exited my vehicle, meeting Cannon head on. Cannon tried to walk around me however I redirected him to the front of my vehicle. Cannon had his hands clenched together in front of his body and I asked him to spread his feet for me. He immediately began to pull away from me however I grabbed him by his arm and conducted an arm bar takedown. Once Cannon was on the ground, I rolled him over and Deputy Lane assisted me in handcuffing him.

While handcuffing, Cannon clenched his hands together again and ignored verbal commands to let go and stop resisting. We were eventually able to pry his fingers apart and place him in handcuffs. Ofc. Stutz arrived on scene, and we stood Cannon up and placed him in the back of his Patrol car. Cannon's only statement to me was something to the effect of "that being an enjoyable rush."

Based on the statement and observations of myself and Sgt. Siracuse, I find probable cause to believe Cannon was in violation of Florida State Statute 843.02 Resisting without Violence.

I transported Cannon to Monroe County Jail without incident.

My BWC was activated for this incident and entered into KWPD Property and Evidence Section.
