**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, REQUESTING
APPROVAL OF THE ATTACHED FEE SCHEDULE
“EXHIBIT A” TO ADJUST THE SIDEWALK CAFÉ
PROGRAM FEES IN THE CITY OF KEY WEST;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Section 2-939 of the City of Key West Land Development Regulations established the City’s Sidewalk Café program and fees associated with the program; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2022, the City Commission adopted draft legislation to adjust regulatory fees associated with this program to further support outdoor dining in the City of Key West by making the program more financially feasible for more businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that an adjustment to the Sidewalk Café regulatory fee is necessary to be responsive to the local restaurant and business community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West finds that outdoor dining supports a healthy community particularly during the Covid-19 pandemic; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the City Commission adopts and approves the attached “Exhibit A: Sidewalk Café/Sidewalk Dining Fee Schedule” in conjunction with approval

of changes to City of Key West Code Section 2-939 to adjust regulatory fees for the Sidewalk Café/Sidewalk Dining program in the City of Key West.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
