**CRB** Applicants

Pursuant to Section 1.07 II (a)(1) below are the nominees proffered to the City Commission for the two (2) open "Commission Appointed" seats for the Citizen Review Board (CRB). The terms for these appointments are four (4) years. If any of the nominees have any type of entries from the FDLE public website or the local Clerk of the Court's website, those results are included in the nominee's package. If the nominee wished to respond to these entries, their written response is also enclosed for your review.

Mr. Tom Milone will not be available for the June 15, 2010 Commission meeting due to his pre-arranged traveling outside the state. Mrs. Talia O'Bryan is missing a sufficient nomination letter from a "community based civic and social service" organization [per sec. 1.07 II (a) (1)] and she has been instructed to tender such a letter directly to the Commission at its June 15, 2010 meeting or she is ineligible for appointment.

Finally, it will be necessary for the City Commission to appoint a replacement CRB member for Mr. Mike Driscoll who has resigned prior to the expiration of his term of June 2011. Thus, any applicants not selected by the City Commission at its June 15, 2010 meeting will "roll over" for this newly vacated seat for the City Commission to consider for appointment at its meeting sometime in July or August of 2010. This recent vacancy is currently being advertised to the public and the deadline for any additional applicants for this position is June 25, 2010.
