A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE
TERM OF THE HISTORIC DISTRICT SIGNAGE TASK
FORCE FOR SIX MONTHS; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 13-266, on October 16, 2013, the
City Commission created the Historic District Signage Task
Force, and in Resolution 13-287 several members of the Task
Force were appointed; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force requires additional time to
prepare recommendations for HARC and the Planning Board
regarding comprehensive amendments to sign regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That term of the Historic District Signage
Task Force is hereby extended for a period of six months.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
