I am writing in support of item #47 on the Agenda, in reference to developing a Master Plan for Bayview Park. Bayview Park is one of our last great green areas on the edge of Old Town and is utilized by a very broad spectrum of people. Developing a Master Plan for this park is just common sense. It is my understanding that there are funds previously approved for this Master Plan, and I see no reason to pursue any major installations (especially artificial turf) in this area until a Master Plan is developed. I am not in favor of item #48 on the agenda. Let's not put the cart before the horse by spending nearly \$1M to install turf that may not align with a Master Plan developed with community input.
