Subject: Approving an interlocal agreement between the City of Key West and Florida Keys

Aqueduct Authority for paving of White Street

Introduction

Engineering staff recommend that the Mayor and City Commission approve an interlocal agreement between the City of Key West (City) and Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority (FKAA) involving asphalt milling and paving along White Street in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 and authorize the City Manager, pursuant to legal review, to execute the agreement and to execute any necessary budget adjustments, transfers, and amendments.

Background

As the FKAA Transmission Terminus Project has included replacement of FKAA infrastructure along White Street, requiring the trenching and subsequent damaging of pavement, FKAA is required to repave a certain portion of White Street. After discussions between FKAA and the City determined that the best course of action is to mill & pave White Street between Newton Street and Fleming Street in its full width, FKAA received a proposal from the contractor, Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. to mill and pave the remainder of the width of White Street not originally included in the FKAA project. Further discussions arrived at a City contribution to the project, as the complete mill & pave of White Street is in the best interest of the City, where FKAA and the City agreed that the City would pay 50% of the additional street paving.

Procurement

The ILA between FKAA and City for White Street paving will be funded in Gas Tax/Streets/ Infrastructure account 102-4102-541-6300, using funds programmed for the City's paving program.

Recommendation

Staff recommend that the Mayor and City Commission approve an interlocal agreement between the City of Key West (City) and Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority (FKAA) involving asphalt milling and paving along White Street in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 and authorize the City Manager, pursuant to legal review, to execute the agreement and to execute any necessary budget adjustments, transfers, and amendments.
