



Blackman turned away from SRT and began to walk away. M Chaustit was the first member to make contact with Blackman and instructed him to stop and to get onto the ground. Blackman did not comply. M Chaustit pushed Blackman on the top left shoulder redirecting him to the ground in a controlled manner. There were no complaints of injury at this time.

Rahming's narrative:

On July 10, 2024, at approximately 1430 hours, the Key West Police Department Special Investigations Unit executed a search warrant at 301 White Street Unit 17A. I, (Detective Jorge Lopez) was the lead case agent. The Key West Police Department Special Response Team (SRT) made initial entry into the residence and secured all occupants. Lieutenant Billy Vasquez, Detective Sergeant Jay Conaty, Detective Henry del Valle, Detective Andrew Hudson, Detective Christian Bozzetti, Detective Leonardo. Hernandez, Detective Tiffani Ane, and Special Agent Cody Shewmake (HSI) assisted with the search warrant execution.

The following occupants were present inside the apartment:

Elizabeth Monet Rahming, (dob:01/24/1992) Xavier Terrell Blackman, (dob:10/21/1985) Rahming's son, Kenry Scott, (dob:01/21/2021)

At the time of the search warrant execution, when (SRT) made entry, Rahming and Blackman were standing near the kitchen. Rahming's child was located inside a bedroom, later labeled as room number 2 on the diagram.

Blackman complained of shoulder pain and Key West Fire Paramedics were requested on scene to assess him and he was medically cleared shortly after.

Unit 17A has three bedrooms, the first bedroom adjacent to the entrance was labeled as room number one on the diagram. The second bedroom across room number one was labeled as room number two on the diagram. The third bedroom on the opposite end of the unit was labeled as room number three.

All occupants of the apartment were escorted downstairs by (SRT) without injury. I later read the search warrant out loud to all occupants at which time no one had any questions. Prior to beginning the search, Detective Christian Bozzetti began a recorded introduction video to document the state of the residence prior to searching.

The following items were inside room one:

- (1) Black scale with white residue inside a microwave. I located this item near the window AC unit. Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for amphetamines.
- (11) Clear baggies with residue, field tested positive for amphetamine. Det. A. Hudson located these baggies inside a plastic bag on the top shelf of the closet.

Det. A. Hudson located the following items in a kitchen drawer:

- (1) Butterfly glass shape tray with several clear baggies lying on top of it.
- (3) Clear baggies with white residue. Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for amphetamine.
- (4) Clear baggies with a white substance, Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for amphetamine. (Weight 2.8 gm).
- (2) Clear baggies with a brown powdery substance, Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for fentanyl. (Weight 1.5 gm).
- (1) Pink/purple plastic bag that contained six individually packaged baggies with fentanyl and amphetamine. (Below listed items).
- (1) Multicolored plastic bag with a hand rolled blunt. The blunt had a white substance inside. Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for amphetamine. (Weight .9 gm).

The above-listed narcotics were located within Rahming and Blackman's reach.

Special Agent Cody Shewmake located three white rock like substances on top of the kitchen cabinets. Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for amphetamine. (Weight .8 gm).

The following items were located in the living room area:

- (1) Clear pipe with a dark spot on the end of it. I located the pipe inside a blue dresser. I located Rahming's debit/credit card and Marijuana card inside the same drawer. I used a field test kit on the dark spot, and it field tested positive for amphetamine.
- (10) Clear baggies with white residue. Det. Bozzetti located two baggies inside a green purse, eight baggies which

he retrieved from a gray couch compartment. Det. H. del Valle used a field test kit, and it tested positive for amphetamine.

(2) Light green baggies with white residue. Det. Sgt. Conaty found these baggies inside a pink/white purse. Det. Bozzetti retrieved the purse from the gray couch compartment.

At the conclusion of the search, Det. H. del Valle packaged all the property and prepared an inventory and return receipt which was left with a copy of the search warrant on a table in the living room area. The above-mentioned items were packaged and placed into the Key West Police Evidence Section. I later filled out FDLE sheets for the narcotics to be sent to the lab for further analysis.

I used my Axon Capture App to photograph the areas where narcotics where located. I later uploaded all the photographs to Evidence.com.

I read Rahming her Miranda Rights, and she invoked her rights.

I read Blackman his Miranda Rights, and he waived his rights to speak with me. I asked Blackman what his relationship was with Rahming, and he described it as a family related friendship. When asked, Blackman indicated that he came to visit Rahming a few minutes ago before (SRT) made entry. I informed Blackman of the substances that were located inside the kitchen drawer. Blackman said he had nothing to do with the drugs found. However, Blackman was standing near the kitchen with Rahming. The distance between the area where Blackman was standing, and the kitchen drawer was approximately 6-7 feet. Blackman and Rahming were the only two adults occupying this unit, and the F.T.P Amphetamine/fentanyl were located within their immediate reach.

This was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.

When Blackman was escorted downstairs and detained, a brown leather wallet was located inside his front pockets. Lt. Vasquez retrieved the wallet from him and then Det. Hudson used a field test kit on the interior of the wallet. The wallet interior residue field tested positive for amphetamine. I used my Axon Capture app and photographed Balckman's wallet and test kit result. I later uploaded it to Evidence.com.

Blackman yelled at Rahming several times demanding her to tell us the truth.

The above-listed address is located in and part of Lang Milan Public Housing Complex, formerly known as Porter Place. This apartment complex is operated by the City of Key West Housing Authority.

Rahming failed to provide her child with the necessary care to maintain her child's physical and mental health that a prudent would consider essential for the well-being of the child. The F.T.P. Fentanyl/Amphetamine was located within the child's immediate reach. Several baggies with F.T.P amphetamine were located in a couch compartment where the child could have easily grab it.

Rahming's mother was identified as Joy Carey, (dob:10/15/1968). Carey responded to the residence to pick up Rahming's child.

The following children occupy the subject's residence:

Kenace Scott, (dob:12/08/20). Kennedy Eugene Scott, (dob:06/18/2019).

Rahming is the biological mother of the children. Kenyatta Scott, (dob:02/17/1992) is the biological father of the children.

Ofc. J. Young later transported Rahming to the Key West Monroe County Detention Center.

Elizabeth Monet Rahming did knowingly and willfully have constructive possession of a Schedule I Substance (Fentanyl), Schedule II Substance (Methamphetamine), Drug Paraphernalia with the intent to sell within Public Housing, and neglect of a child contrary to the Florida Statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.

I later contacted The Department of Children and Families to report Rahming's negligence, and actions that cou	ld
significantly affect/physically hurt the children's health. I spoke with Irma, (Social worker), badge 340.

narcotics to be sent to the lab for further analysis.

I used my Axon Capture App to photograph the areas where narcotics where located. I later uploaded all the photographs to Evidence.com.

I read Rahming her Miranda Rights, and she invoked her rights.

I read Blackman his Miranda Rights, and he waived his rights to speak with me. I asked Blackman what his relationship was with Rahming, and he described it as a family related friendship. When asked, Blackman indicated that he came to visit Rahming a few minutes ago before (SRT) made entry. I informed Blackman of the substances that were located inside the kitchen drawer. Blackman said he had nothing to do with the drugs found. However, Blackman was standing near the kitchen with Rahming. The distance between the area where Blackman was standing, and the kitchen drawer was approximately 6-7 feet. Blackman and Rahming were the only two adults occupying this unit, and the F.T.P Amphetamine/fentanyl were located within their immediate reach.

This was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.

When Blackman was escorted downstairs and detained, a brown leather wallet was located inside his front pockets. Lt. Vasquez retrieved the wallet from him and then Det. Hudson used a field test kit on the interior of the wallet. The wallet interior residue field tested positive for amphetamine. I used my Axon Capture app and photographed Balckman's wallet and test kit result. I later uploaded it to Evidence.com.

Blackman yelled at Rahming several times demanding her to tell us the truth.

The above-listed address is located in and part of Lang Milan Public Housing Complex, formerly known as Porter Place. This apartment complex is operated by the City of Key West Housing Authority.

Rahming failed to provide her child with the necessary care to maintain her child's physical and mental health that a prudent would consider essential for the well-being of the child. The F.T.P. Fentanyl/Amphetamine was located within the child's immediate reach. Several baggies with F.T.P amphetamine were located in a couch compartment where the child could have easily grab it.

Rahming's mother was identified as Joy Carey, (dob:10/15/1968). Carey responded to the residence to pick up Rahming's child.

Detective Bozzetti had removed the pink and white bag from a storage compartment underneath the living room couch cushion. The small green baggies field-tested positive (FTP) for amphetamine residue.

On July 10, 2024, the Key West Police Department Special Response Team executed a search warrant at 301 White Street apartment 17A. I was designated as the breacher for this operation. SRT approached the residence and from the west side of the property. We climbed the stairway to the front door of the residence. The front door was locked and had to be breached. I positioned myself in front of the doorway and knocked hard on the door while everyone on the entry teal shouted, "Key West Police. Search Warrant". I knocked and announced for approximately 8 to 10 seconds. No one in the residence answered the door. I used the department issued breaching tools to open the front door.

Once the front door was open, I saw a black male, identified as Xavier Blackman standing in the living room area. From out side of the threshold, I gave Blackman several loud verbal command to get on the ground. Blackman refused to comply with my lawful order, turned and started to retreat into the residence. I entered the residence and continued to give Blackman loud verbal commands to stop and get on the ground. Blackman continued to ignore lawful commands. I pursued Blackman through the living room area and pushed him to the ground. Once on the ground i instructed Blackman to put his hands behind his back. Blackman tried to get back up to his feet, I pushed him back on the ground and told him to put his hands behind his back again. Once again Blackman refused and attempted to get to his feet again. I stepped on Blackman's right scapula with my left foot and applied downward pressure to prevent him from getting back to his feet. I instructed him to place his hands behind his back and he complied. I released the downward pressure on Blackman's scapula when he complied with my lawful commands. Blackman was secured in handcuffs and removed from the residence.
