**A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY (CRA), AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF ONE
SURPLUS FLOATING STRUCTURE, PROVIDED THE SALE
AMOUNT EQUALS OR EXCEEDS \$42,000.00; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 2-771(3)c of the Code of Ordinances, the City may sell surplus personal property; and

WHEREAS, the floating structure served as the Dockmaster's office at Key West Bight until the Dockmaster was moved to into the renovated Thompson Fish House; and

WHEREAS, the floating structure was not allowed to remain in the Key West Bight, pursuant to the current submerged land lease with the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of September 16, 2009, the Key West Bight Board approved the concept of selling the floating structure to the highest bidder over an established reserve minimum bid of \$42,000.00, along with an opportunity to lease a liveaboard slip in the City Marina at Garrison Bight;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the sale of the floating structure previously used as the Dockmaster's office is hereby authorized, provided the sale amount equals or exceeds \$42,000.00.

Section 2: That the successful bidder shall be offered the opportunity to enter into a standard agreement to dock the floating structure at the City Marina at Garrison Bight.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
