



Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

On 10/27/2025, at approximately 2300 hours, I, Officer Sharp, responded to the Fairfield Inn (3852 N. Roosevelt Boulevard), reference a verbal disturbance involving multiple parties. Upon arrival, I met with Phil Badgwell and Sarah Badgwell (Arrestee, DOB: 10/20/1980). Both appeared very agitated and explained to me in a rushed manner that another subject, later identified as Alison Blake (Arrestee, DOB: 08/19/1975), had stolen Sarah Badgwell's phone earlier at Garden of Eden (224 Duval Street).

Sarah stated that she used Phil's phone and the Life360 tracking app to locate her stolen phone, which tracked to the Fairfield Inn, room 108. Sarah then spontaneously uttered that Alison refused to give her the phone back so she "...grabbed Alison by the throat" and threw her to the ground.

At that time, Fairfield Inn Security member Kian Vanderhoof (IO, DOB: 05/03/2006) stated that Alison was next to us and was bleeding badly from the back of the head, describing it as "bad." Wanting to assure Alison's medical condition and safety, I called for Rescue and located Alison a few feet away, with Kian Vanderhoof standing by with the Badgwells.

A short time later, Kian advised me that both Phil and Sarah Badgwell had taken off running from the scene. I confirmed that Alison was bleeding heavily from the back of her head. I asked Alison to sit down for her safety due to her apparent head injury, and she complied initially.

When I asked Alison for identification, she stated that she "...didn't have to identify herself to me." Alison continued to act exceedingly aggressively, including standing up and attempting to walk away from me, screaming, and refusing all lawful commands. I attempted to grab Alison's arm to detain her, at which point she pulled away from me. This physically evasive maneuver was clearly intended to defeat my attempts of control.

I placed Alison in handcuffs and positioned her against the wall in an attempt to limit her mobility. Alison continued to actively resist my attempts by pulling away and tensing her body, leading me to take her to the ground in a controlled manner to gain compliance.

Officers Andrade, Ua, Adorno, and Floryance responded to the scene for assistance. Sgt. Waite and Sgt. Miller also responded to the scene. Rescue 3 responded and cleared Alison of her injuries.

Kian Vanderhoof further stated he witnessed the Badgwells confront Alison, who refused to give over the phone, and when it pinged in her purse is when the altercation occurred and the phone was recovered from Alison's purse.

After speaking to myself, Sgt. Miller and Sgt. Waite, Alison continued her aggressive and combative behavior, continuously denying her involvement in the theft and denying resisting my law enforcement investigation.

Ofc. Andrade and Ofc. Adorno later located Sarah Badgwell at La Concha (430 Duval Street), where she was placed under arrest for battery.

Ofc. Andrade transported Badgwell to Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

Based on my investigation, there is probable cause to believe that Sarah Badgwell did commit the offense of battery when she intentionally and unlawfully struck Alison Blake by grabbing her by the throat and throwing her to the ground, against Blake's will. This act caused visible injury, as Alison was observed actively bleeding from the back of her head. Sarah admitted to the physical act spontaneously while speaking to me, stating she "grabbed Alison by the throat" and threw her down. This constitutes intentional, unwanted physical contact as defined under Florida Statute 784.03(1)(a)(1).

Based on my investigation, probable cause exists to believe that Alison Blake did commit the offense of Grand Theft (Third Degree Felony) when she unlawfully took Sarah Badgwell's Apple iPhone from the Garden of Eden located at 224 Duval Street, with the intent to temporarily or permanently deprive Sarah of the property or its benefit.

Sarah used the Life360 tracking application to trace the phone directly to Alison's location at the Fairfield Inn, where Alison was located shortly thereafter and found in possession of the stolen item and confronted by the victim The stolen item, an iPhone, is valued over \$750. This meets the statutory value threshold for Grand Theft (Third Degree Felony) under Florida Statute 812.014(2)(c)(1).

Further probable cause exists to believe that Alison Blake did knowingly and willfully resist, obstruct, or oppose a law enforcement officer in the lawful execution of a legal duty, without offering or doing violence, when she repeatedly refused lawful commands, attempted to walk away from me during an investigation, pulled away as I attempted to detain her, and physically tensed up while being handcuffed. These actions constitute resisting an officer without violence in violation of Florida Statute 843.02.

My AXON in-car and BWC were activated during this call and later uploaded to evidence.com.
