A RESOLUTION OF THE SUSTAINABILITY

FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING A

(BUFFERED) / (PARKING PROTECTED) FLAGLER
AVENUE BICYCLE FACILITY DESIGN
ALTERNATIVE IN THE CITY OF KEY WEST;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-024 created the Sustainability Advisory Board to advise and assist the City Commission in efforts to make City operations and the community as a whole more sustainable; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-009 directed staff to work with the County and State to create policies and goals for right-of-way projects to incorporate "Complete and Sustainable Streets" and the target of "Vision Zero", setting a "Vision Zero" goal to achieve zero collision-caused right-of-way fatalities and serious injuries by the year 2035; and

WHEREAS, Monroe County maintains Flagler Avenue east of First Street in Key West and has tasked their consultant to begin roadway design on that roadway; and

WHEREAS, Monroe County is seeking a roadway design recommendation to advance within the roadway design process; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Sustainability Advisory Board
finds that a _(buffered) /(parking protected) Flagler Avenue
bicycle facility design alternative will enhance the health
and safety of residents of the City of Key West.
Section 2: That the Sustainability Advisory Board
recommends the City Commission of the City of Key West support
and advance a(buffered) / (parking protected) Flagler
Avenue bicycle facility design alternative where feasible.
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication
by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of
the Sustainability Advisory Board.
