

- \$137,547 passenger fee revenue


# Mallory T-Pier

- \$4,483 passenger fee revenue




# **Ferry Terminal**


- 13,713 total ferry passengers

# City Marina @ Garrison Bight


- \$105,267 transient, commercial and recreational dockage revenue

- \$5,496 ramp fees and parking revenue






### **Key West Historic Seaport**
