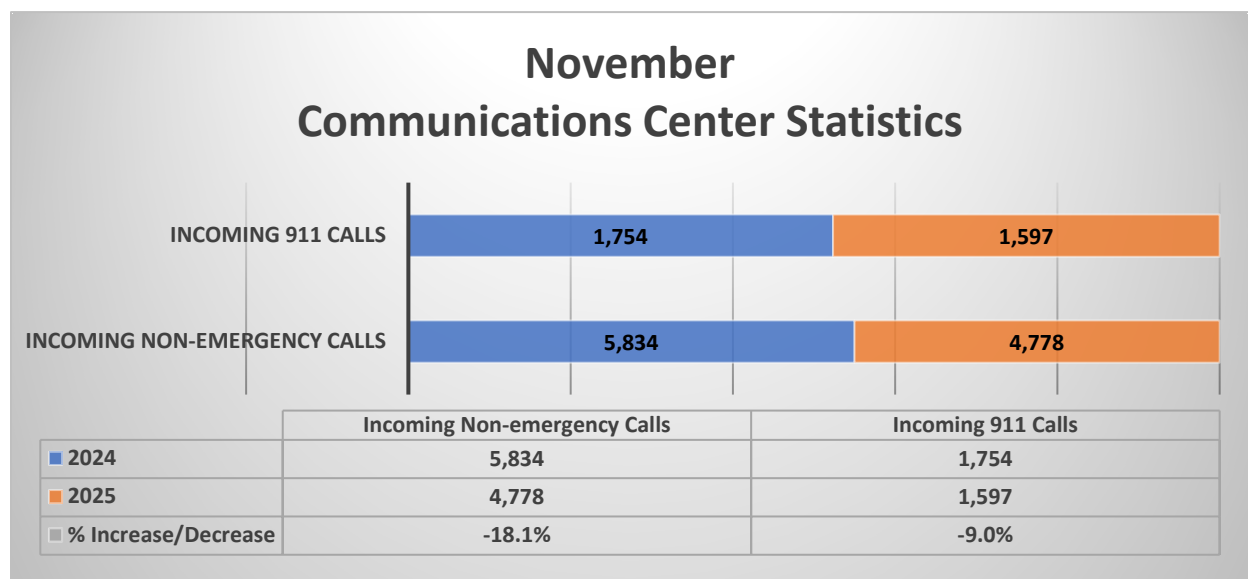
Subject: Monthly Report – November 2025

In November 2025, the Key West Police Department’s Communication Center received 4,778 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,597 came directly to 911. Compared to November 2024, we experienced a 9.0% decrease in 911 calls, and an 18.1% decrease in non-emergency calls.

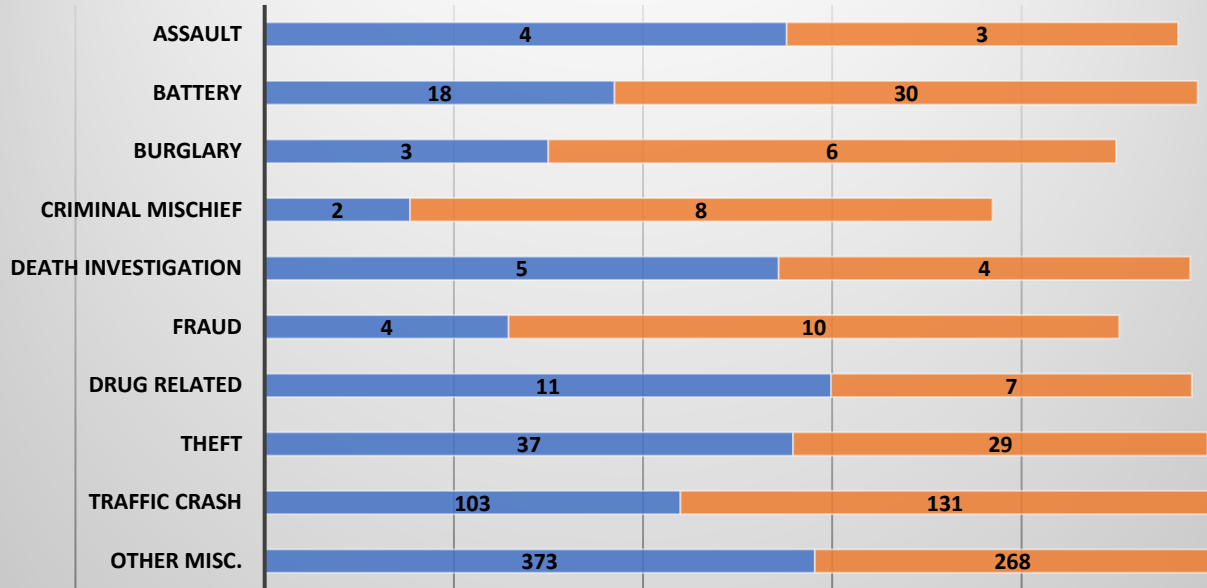
Officers completed 496 police reports, and 135 arrests were made. Compared to November 2024, police reports decreased by 11.4% and arrests decreased by 4.9%.

A total of 899 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 186 citations and 198 written warnings. Compared to November 2024, traffic stops increased by 18.3%, written warning increased by 38.5% and citations increased by 19.2%.

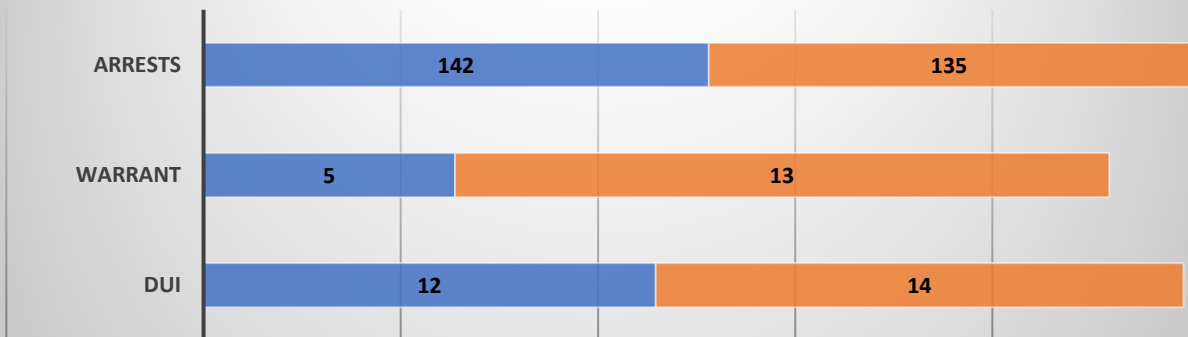

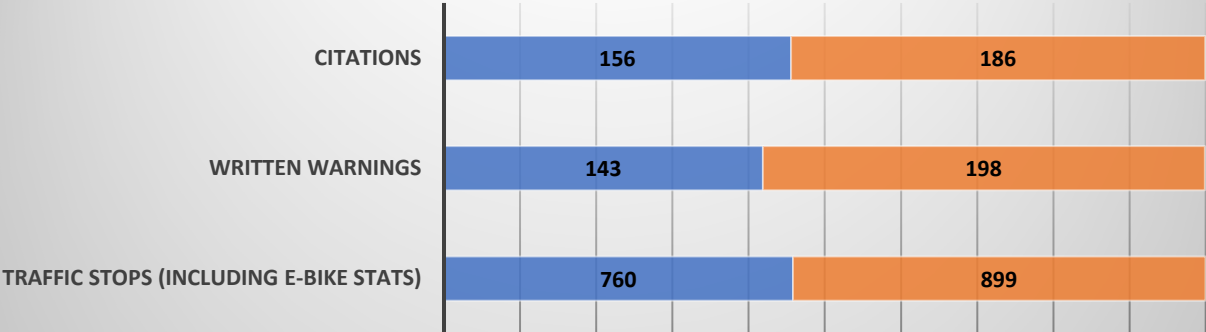
