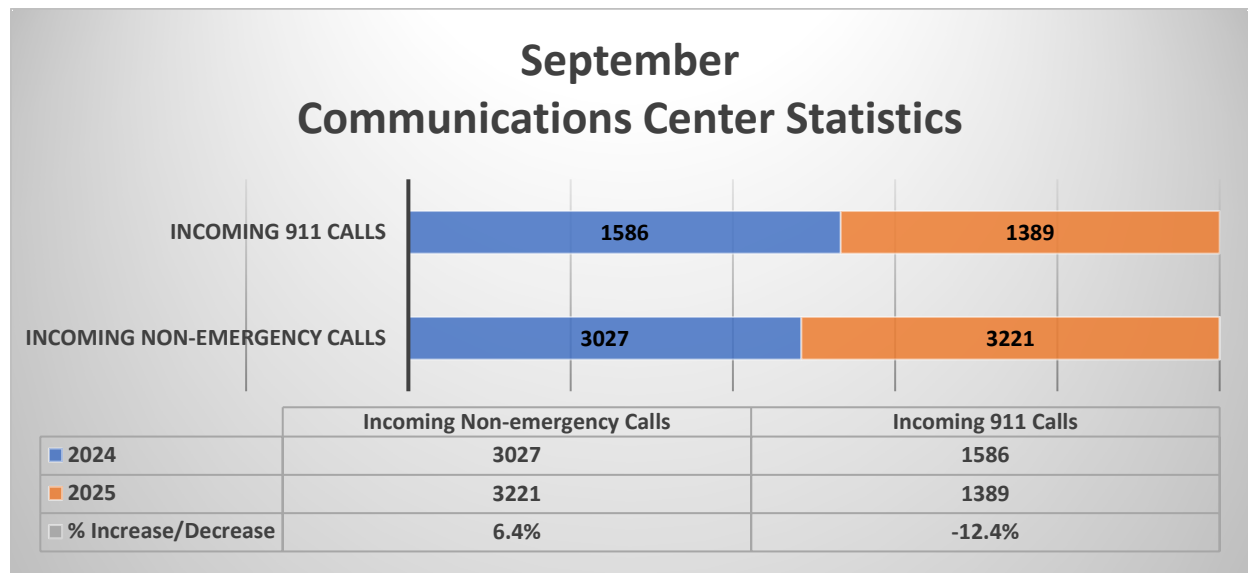
Subject: Monthly Report – September 2025

In September 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 4,610 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,389 came directly to 911. Compared to September 2024, we experienced a 12.4% decrease in 911 calls, a 6.4% increase in non-emergency calls.

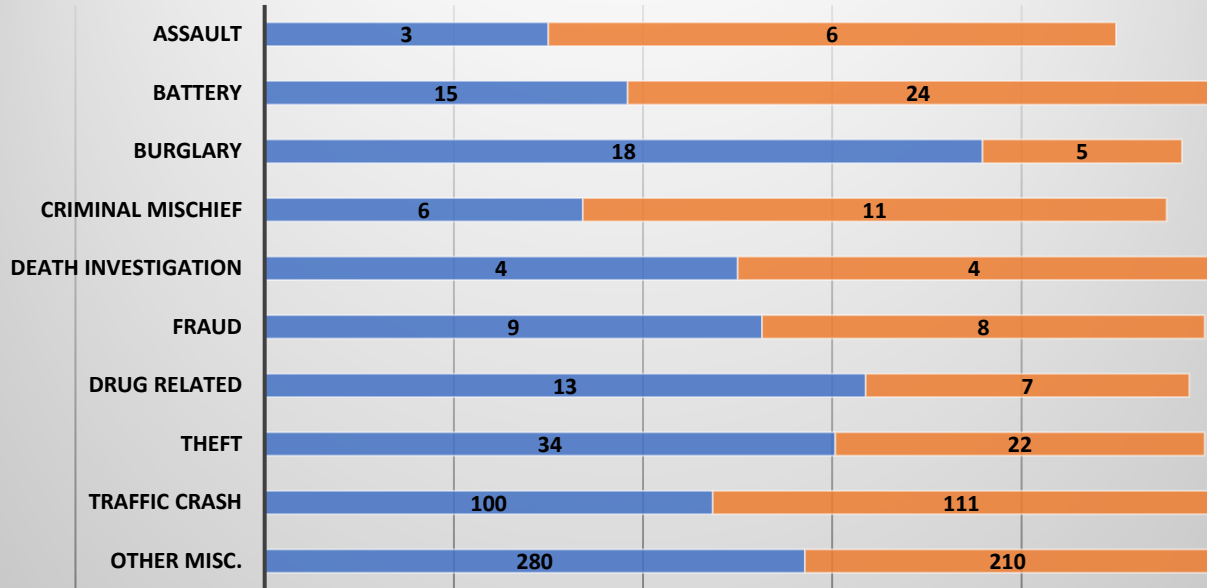
Officers completed 408 police reports and 122 arrests were made. Compared to September 2024, police reports decreased by 15% and arrests decreased by 6.2%.

A total of 982 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 246 citations and 202 written warnings.

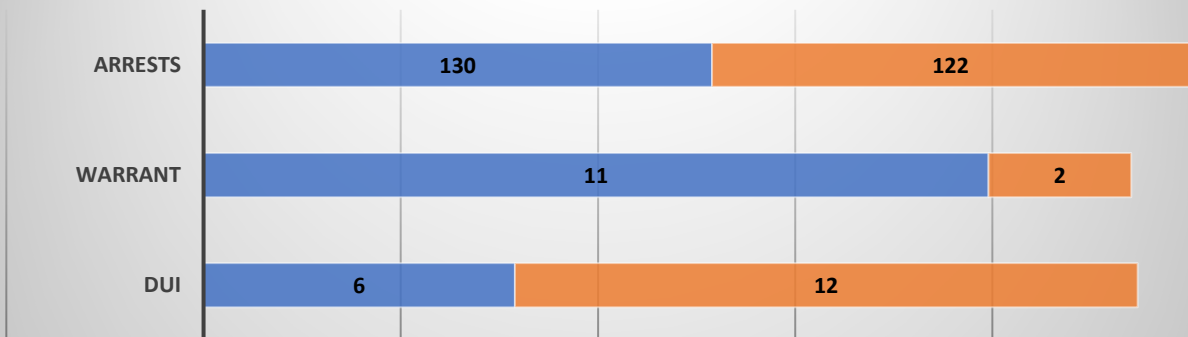

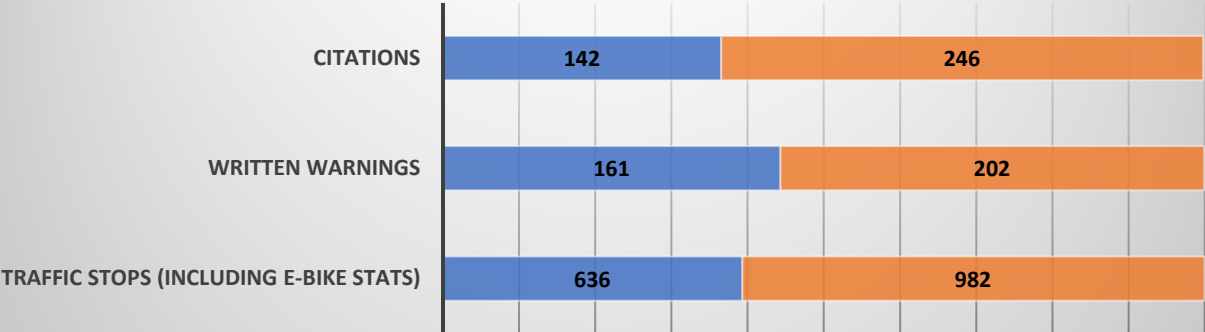
