A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE "CONSULTING AGREEMENT" BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND LANGTON ASSOCIATES, INC., AND IN REM SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR GRANT WRITING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE ADDITIONAL YEAR; APPROVING THE COMPENSATION RATE OF \$5,500 PER MONTH, NOT TO EXCEED \$66,000.00 PER YEAR; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 13-071, the City Commission awarded the bid to Langton Associates, Inc. and IN REM Solutions, Inc. in response to RFQ No. 002-13 for Grant Writing Services; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 13-112, the City Commission ratified a consulting agreement for a one-year period through March 5, 2014, containing provisions for up to two one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 14-070, the City Commission approved a one-year extension of the consulting agreement; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of the second of two one-year extensions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a one-year extension of the attached "Consulting Agreement" between the City of Key West and Langton Associates, Inc., and IN REM Solutions, Inc. for Grant Writing Services is hereby approved, for the period beginning March 6, 2015.

Section 2: That the rate of compensation is approved and shall remain at \$5,500 per month, not to exceed \$66,000 per year, commencing March 6, 2015.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
