## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE KEY SOUTHERNMOST RUNNERS CLUB TO HOLD THE DUVAL MILE RUN ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2025, FROM 6:00 P.M. 5:00 P.M.) 7:00 P.M. (SET-UP ATON **DUVAL** STREET; AUTHORIZING CLOSURE OF **CERTAIN** THE OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID RACE FROM TO 7:00 P.M.; AND PROVIDING 5:00 P.M. FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Key West Southernmost Runners Club wishes to conduct the "Duval Mile Run" on Duval Street during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. (set-up at 5:00 p.m.) on Saturday, October 11, 2025;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic

straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To Go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Key West Southernmost Runners Club is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That Key West Southernmost Runners Club will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrel will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That Key West Southernmost Runners Club pledges that proceeds will benefit St. Mary's Star of the Sea Basilica Catholic School.

SECTION 6. That Key West Southernmost Runners Club acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
