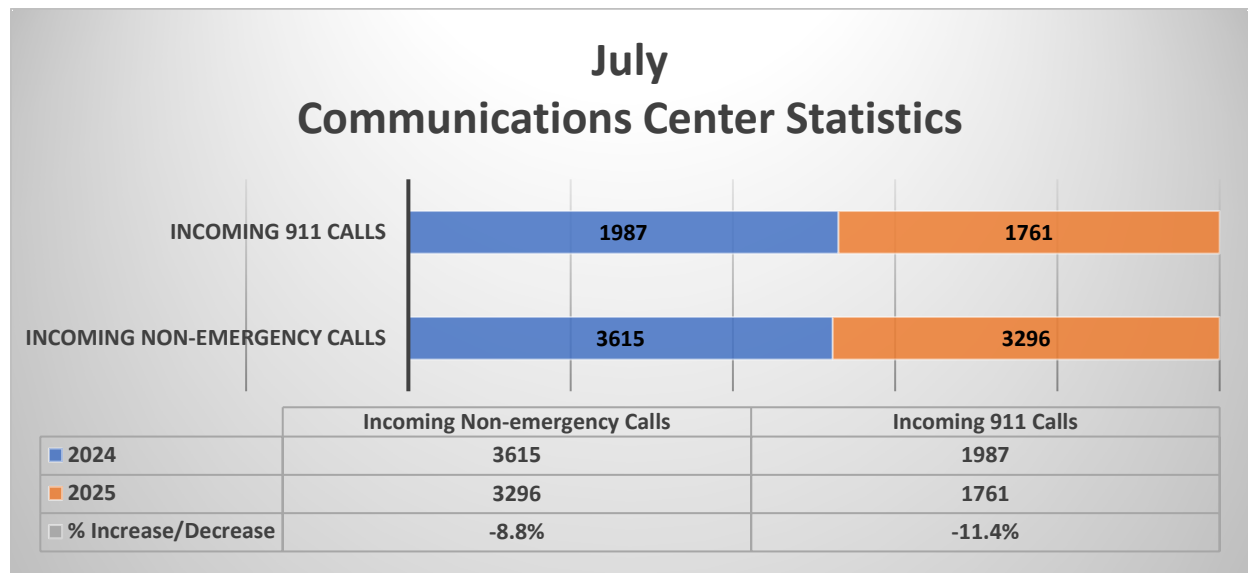
Subject: Monthly Report – July 2025

In July 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 5,057 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,761 came directly to 911. Compared to July 2024, we experienced an 11.4% decrease in 911 calls and an 8.8% decrease in non-emergency calls.

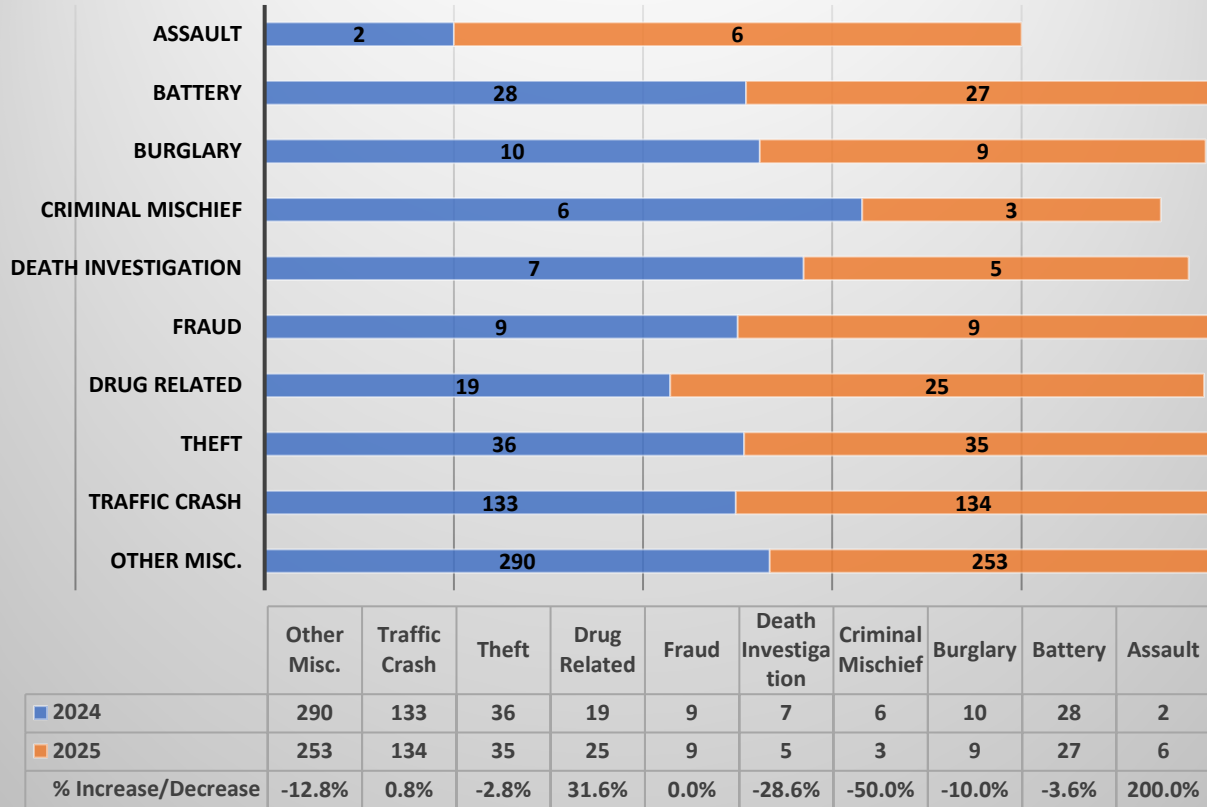
Officers completed 481 police reports and 121 arrests were made. Compared to July 2024, police reports decreased by 10.9% and arrests decreased by 24.4%.

A total of 1101 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 256 citations and 304 written warnings.

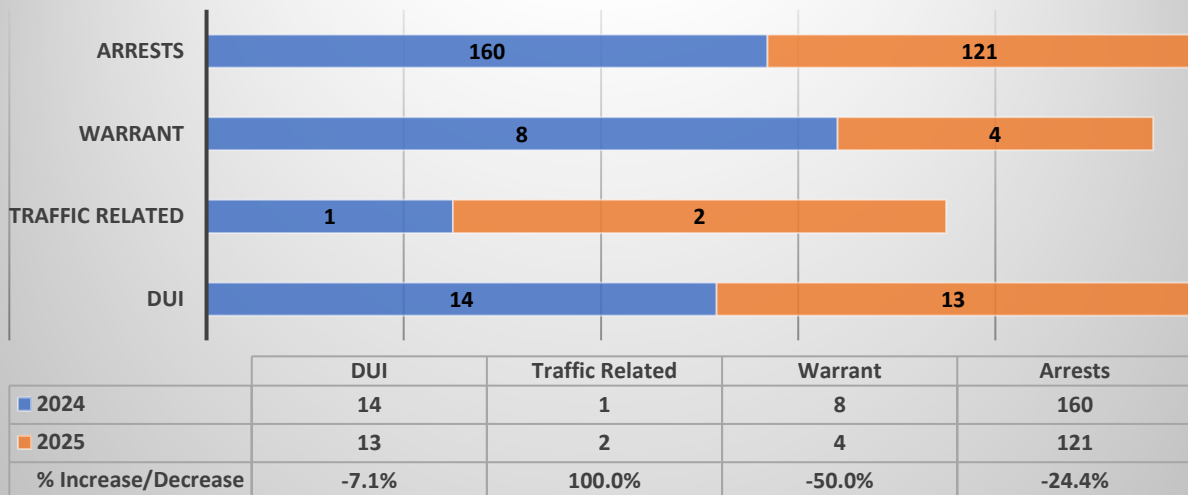

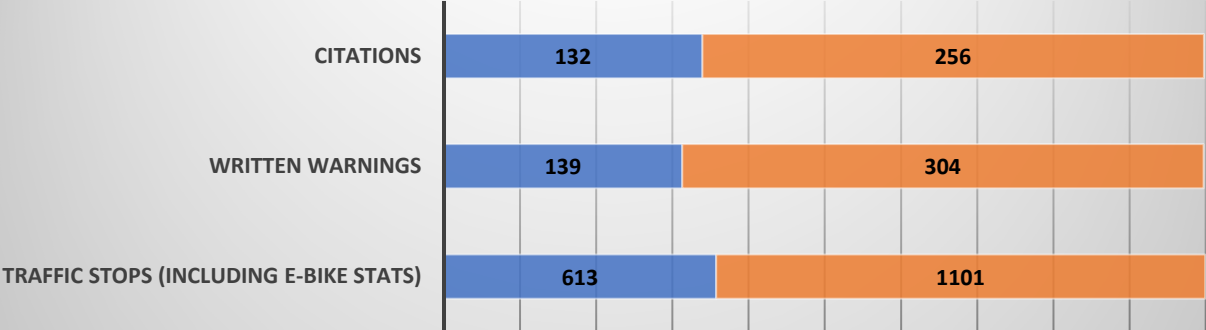
