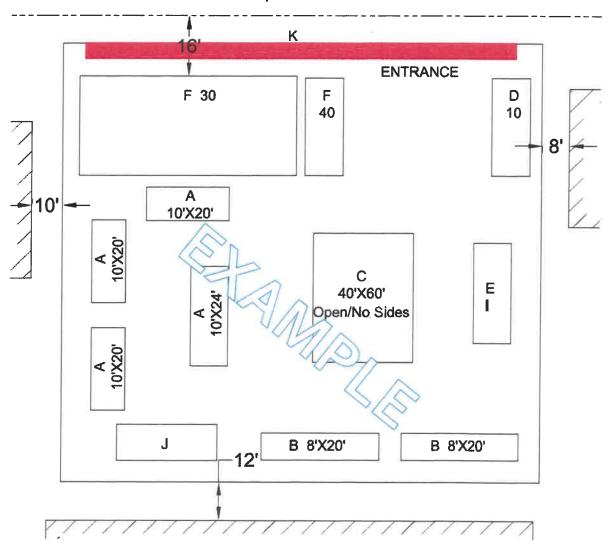

Fire lanes are along the left (North side of Duval, tents are to the right (South).

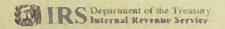
