A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF METERED PARKING SPACES IN THE 1900 TO 2600 BLOCKS ALONG SOUTH ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD (BY SMATHERS BEACH) PURSUANT TO SECTION 70-31(a) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO WORK WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO PERMIT SUCH METERED PARKING ALONG STATE-OWNED RIGHT-OF WAY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, section 70-31(a) of the Code of Ordinances authorizes the City Manager to designate parking spaces, and to seek the advice and consent of the city commission for such decisions; and

WHEREAS, City staff has sampled parking in the blocks being considered for metering along South Roosevelt Boulevard, and determined that a majority of vehicles belong to visitors, and that it would be reasonable and appropriate to add those blocks to the Residential Parking Permit program pursuant to Section 70-249(c), so that Key West residents would be able to enjoy free parking for up to four hours daily; and

WHEREAS, City staff finds and recommends that the addition of metered parking spaces on the 1900-2600 blocks of South Roosevelt Boulevard would have limited impact on Key West residents and increase annual parking revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the designation of metered parking spaces in the 1900-2600 blocks of South Roosevelt Boulevard is hereby approved.

Section 2: There is adequate funding in the proposed FY 19-20 budget for the creation of metered parking spaces, including up to five parking pay stations for the 1900-2600 blocks of South Roosevelt Boulevard. (The costs are expected to be offset by increased parking revenue.)

Section 3: That City staff is authorized to provide necessary plans and documentation to the Florida Department of Transportation District 6, to install such the metered parking along the State of Florida-owned right-of-way.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
