**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING MEL FISHER DAYS, INC. TO CONDUCT A 2015 CELEBRATION OF THE FINDING OF THE ATOCHA ON SATURDAY, JULY 11, 2015 DURING THE HOURS OF 12:00 NOON TO 10:00 P.M. AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF THE 200 & 300 BLOCK OF DUVAL STREET FROM GREENE TO EATON STREET AND CAROLINE FROM TELEGRAPH TO ANN FROM 9:00 A.M. TO 11:50 P.M; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 10:30 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Mel Fisher Days Inc. has applied to the City for a Special Event Permit for A Celebration of the finding of the “Atocha” Saturday, July 11, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, this event shall take place on the 100 & 200 block of Duval Street and Caroline Street from Telegraph to Ann between the hours of 12:00 noon to 10:00 p.m; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

**SECTION 1.** That Mel Fisher Days, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct an Anniversary Celebration of the finding of the Atocha on the day and during the hours stated above; **PROVIDED** that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and that 25 % of gross revenue or \$1,000.00, whichever is more, shall be donated to the Wesley House Family Services, Inc..

**SECTION 2.** That Mel Fisher Days, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the closure of the 100 & 200 block of Duval Street from Greene to Eaton Street and Caroline Street from

Telegraph Lane to Ann Street on the date and during the hours stated above.

**SECTION 3.** That Mel Fisher Days, Inc. is granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

**SECTION 4.** That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Mel Fisher Days, Inc is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

**SECTION 5.** That Mel Fisher Days, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side;

**SECTION 6.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
