On Saturday, February 16, 2019, approximately 2113 Hours, Officer Dehanas and I, Officer Perez were dispatched to Elizabeth and Southard Street, reference a white male damaging vehicle parked on the side of the road.

Upon arrival, Sergeant Stockton was on scene and had contacted the white male suspect. Sergeant Stockton said he had identified himself as Key Police Officer and was wearing his Class B uniform, had given several verbal commands to the white male to stop and to get on the ground or he will be Tased. The white male ignored Sergeant Stockton's commands and ran around several blocks in to the backyard of a property located near the intersection of William Street and Southard Street.

Officer Dehanas and I, arrived at the scene, wearing class B uniform, and ran into the backyard of the property located at William Street and Southard Street, discovering later the property is 830 Southard Street. Officer Dehanas identified himself as a Key West Police Officer. The white male suspect took off running and jumped another fence landing on the property directly next to 830 Southard Street. This property was later discovered as being 822 Southard Street. Officer Dehanas and I, also jumped the fence and followed the suspect. The suspect continued fleeing finally jumping over a second fence which lead into the property located at 715 Bakers Lane. Officer Dehanas continued to follow the suspect yelling loud verbal commands to stop running and to get on the ground. The suspect ignored Officer Deahanas and my commands.

Officer Dehanas and I, jumped the second fence, pursuing the suspect. Officer Dehanas attempted deploy the taser on the suspect, but only one probe make contact with him. The suspect then fell to the ground after the one taser probe struck him. Officer Dehanas and I, then tried to handcuff the suspect, but he continued to resist by hiding his arms under his body. Officer Dehanas gave the suspect several loud verbal commands to stop resisting. Officer Dehanas deliver three drive stun cycles to the suspect in order to gain compliance. Officer Dehanas and I were finally successful in gaining compliance and handcuffed the suspect.

The suspect was later identified as Joshua L. Wells (DOB 08/03/1984. Wells suffered several scratches on his chest, a cut above the left eye. Wells was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center to be examine for injuries. Wells was later released from the ER. I transported Wells to The Monroe County Detention Center, without further incidents.

I was then approached by a white male, Later Identified as Joshua P. Hobson (DOB 04/11/1974). Hobson said he observed Wells make several attempts to break the sideview mirror of several vehicles parked on the side of the road on Elizabeth Street. Hobson told me he followed Wells for a few minutes and observed Wells breaking the sideview mirror of a white Ford pickup truck.

Based on the facts, evidence and my direct observations, there is probable cause to believe On 02/06/2019 at about 2113 Hours, Wells, did actually and intentionally damaged the sideview mirror of a Ford Pickup truck, bearing FL Tag HYJV25, in violation of F.S.S 806.13-1B1. Wells did actually and intentionally, resist/obstruct an officer w/o violence in violation of F.S.S. 843.02.

On 02/16/19, at approximately 2119hrs, I (Ofc. B. DeHanas) responded as backup to a criminal mischief incident near the intersection of Southard Street and William Street.

This incident involves Joseph Wells, who was reported to have committed several acts of criminal mischief.

My involvement in this case is as follows:

Sgt. J. Stockton previously aired over Key West Police Department Communications (COMM 1) that Joseph Wells ran from him. I assisted Sgt. J. Stockton and Ofc. S. Perez in searching for Joseph on the property of 830 William Street. While searching for Joseph, Ofc. S. Perez shouted for Joseph to stop. Ofc. S. Perez told me Joseph climbed over the fence onto the property of 822 William Street. I climbed over the fence onto the property of 822 William Street to pursue Joseph. I heard a bunch of bushes and trees rustling across the yard. I displayed my department issued Taser device and told Joseph to stop. Joseph did not stop or obey my lawful orders. I deployed my Taser device. I climbed the fence onto 715 Bakers Lane in order to continue pursuit of Joseph. Joseph was across the yard on the ground. I told Joseph to get on the ground and place his hands behind his back or I was going to deploy my Taser device again. Joseph did not comply with my lawful order. I deployed my Taser device again. Still, Joseph did not comply with my lawful order to place his hands behind his back. I drive stunned Joseph with my Taser device in order to get him to comply with my lawful order. After I drive stunned Joseph, he complied, placed his hands behind his back, where I then placed him into custody.

I aired over COMM 1 that I deployed my Taser device as well as drive stunned Joseph. Ofc. S. Perez called for rescue to respond to the scene. I collected my Taser device cartridge and turned it over to Sgt. J. Stockton.

This concludes my involvement in this incident.
