A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A DESIGN TASK ORDER TO KEITH & SCHNARS, P.A. FOR SIMONTON STREET RESURFACING AND AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) IMPROVEMENTS FROM OLIVIA STREET TO SIMONTON BEACH, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$103,010.00; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-207, the City Commission approved a three-year contract with an option for one two-year extension with Keith & Schnars, P.A. for General Engineering Consulting Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached design task order for Keith & Schnars, P.A. for Simonton Street Resurfacing and ADA Improvements from Olivia Street to Simonton Beach, is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$103,010.00.

Section 2: Funds are budgeted in the Infrastructure Fund account #102-4102-541-6300, and necessary budget transfers are authorized, from Project Number II41021802 to Project Number II41021804, to finance this project.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
