

RESOLUTION NO. 14-009

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FIVE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH SYNCROMATICS CORPORATION FOR REAL TIME PASSENGER INFORMATION SYSTEM (RTPI) MANAGEMENT/HOSTING FOR USE IN KEY WEST DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BUSES ON A SOLE SOURCE BASIS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(1) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 08-087, the City Commission awarded a bid for a Real Time Passenger Information system (RTPI), including hardware, software, installation and five years of annual operating costs, to Syncromatics, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the initial five year period has expired, and City staff recommends approval of an additional five-year agreement, on a sole source basis, to ensure ongoing support, repairs and upgrades as they become available;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a five-year agreement between the City and Syncromatics Corporation for management/hosting of the real time passenger information system is hereby approved, pursuant to section 2-797(1) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.


