A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE WEST. FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CITY OF KEY EXECUTIVE ADVENTURES. LLC **DBA** WORLD SAILFISH CHAMPIONSHIP TO CONDUCT A WORLD **SAILFISH CHAMPIONSHIP** AND TOURNAMENT FESTIVITIES AT MALLORY SQUARE PLAZA STARTING TUESDAY, APRIL 17TH THROUGH SATURDAY. APRIL 21<sup>TH</sup>, 2012, FROM 12:00 NOON TO 12:00 MIDNIGHT( SET UP APRIL 13 - 17, 2012 AND BREAKDOWN APRIL 21-23, 2012); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 12:00 MIDNIGHT; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED **YEAR** APPROVING A FIVE CONTRACT STARTING ON 2012 THROUGH 2016 WITH EXECUTIVE ADVENTURES; PROVIDING **PAYMENTS** TO THE CITY:PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECITVE DATE

WHEREAS, Executive Adventures LLC dba World Sailfish Championship wishes to conduct a World Sailfish Championship and Tournament Festivities at Mallory Square Plaza between the hours of 12:00 noon to 12:00 midnight on Tuesday, April 17<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, April 21, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the City Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the sponsors anticipate that amplified music will be played during the event;

WHEREAS, Executive Adventures LLC dba World Sailfish Championship would like to receive a five year contract starting in 2012 through 2016;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That Executive Adventures, LLC dba World Sailfish

Championship is hereby granted permission to conduct a Special Event on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and 25% of gross revenue or \$1000.00, whichever is greater, shall be donated to the World Sailfish Championship Charitable Foundation.

**SECTION 2.** That Executive Adventures, LLC dba World Sailfish

Championship is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key

West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Executive Adventures, LLC dba World Sailfish Championship is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

**SECTION 4.** That Executive Adventures, LLC dba World Sailfish Championship shall pay a user fee in the amount of \$2,500.00 to the City of Key West. The City will provide six (6) free parking spaces with this user fee.

**SECTION 5.** That Executive Adventures, LLC dba World Sailfish Championship shall be given permission for a five year contract starting 2012 through 2016.

**SECTION 6.** That Executive Adventures, LLC dba World Sailfish

Championship will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1)

recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 7.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.

# WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, World Sailfish desires to hold an annual event commonly referred to as the World Sailfish Championship at Mallory Square in the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to set forth their mutual understanding in a formal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, World Sailfish requires the provision of additional or extraordinary support services from City in order that said the said event may be held in Key West, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, it is mutually agreed between City and the World Sailfish as follows:

### 1. Term:

The term of this agreement shall be for five (5) years commencing on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2011, and shall apply to World Sailfish Championship activities to be held during the years 2012 through 2016 for a period of ten days annually. Each year, no fewer than 90 days before the event, World Sailfish shall supply the City the schedule of events for that year, which shall become an attachment to this Agreement.

### 2. Demised Area:

World Sailfish shall have the use of Mallory Square and parking spaces in the adjacent parking lot as shown on the attached Exhibit "A", hereinafter the "Demised Area". City reserves the right, upon notice given within 30 days after the event ends, to re-locate the event for the succeeding year to a comparable sized area in the Truman Waterfront upon completion of the park improvements. In the event that World Sailfish does not agree with the re-location, World Sailfish shall have the right at its sole option and as its sole remedy, to terminate this agreement, within 30 days of the receipt of the re-location notice.

### 3. Use:

a. World Sailfish may utilize the Demised Area for the purposes of holding activities consistent with the World Sailfish Championship including the placement of tents for the event, Sponsor Village, food and alcohol, and concert area.

- b. World Sailfish shall work with the City who will coordinate the use of the Demised Area with the Cultural Preservation Society, Waterfront Playhouse, and all other businesses surrounding Mallory Square to provide for minimum business disruption. In no circumstance shall World Championship's use of the Demised Area negatively affect ingress and egress to Mallory Square.
- c. World Sailfish will comply with all laws and city ordinances governing use of city property, including but not limited to, consumption of alcohol, noise control and exemptions, and will obtain any and all necessary permits, including special event permits, licenses and/or approvals that may be required.

### 4. User Fees

a. World Sailfish shall pay the City a user fee as follows:

2012 \$3500.00 2013 \$4000.00 2014 \$4500.00 2015 \$5000.00 2016 \$5000.00

World Sailfish shall also pay the daily rate of thirty two dollars (\$32) for each parking space, which sum shall be due and payable no later than 30 days after World Championship ceases use of the Demised Area each year of the event. There will be no additional charge for the parking lot should the event choose to have a free concert for the City.

b. Additionally, World Sailfish agrees to make charitable contributions to local and/or national 501(c)3 organizations of World Championship's choosing. World Sailfish agrees to provide to the City an affidavit and accounting of the revenue and distribution of the charitable contributions within 90 days of the completion of the event, annually.

# 5. Payment for City Services

a. Pursuant to section 6-26 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West, World Sailfish shall pay the actual cost for the provision of additional or extraordinary services, as requested by World Sailfish, and provided by the City, in addition to all other fees provided for in section 6-26. No later than 30 days after World Championship ceases use of the Demised Area each year of the event, the City will provide to World Sailfish an itemized invoice of actual costs incurred for all services, in accordance with the then current rate schedule, rendered in connection with the events approved by this Agreement. No later than 30 days after receipt of the said invoice, World Championship shall make payment to City. Should there be any additional costs incurred by the city as the result of additional labor or equipment provided by the City, World Sailfish shall be informed by the City as soon as practical and prior to providing the service. World Sailfish may elect to provide the additional

services required.

- b. World Sailfish Championship shall submit a security plan for approval by the City. Should the City determine that additional security is required, World Sailfish will contract and pay for security that may be provided by private Class D guards or law enforcement officers from the Key West Police Department, for the required number of personnel for the event. Proof of said contracts for security must be furnished to and approved by the City at least ten days before the event.
- c. The City department spokesperson or contact person providing the services shall immediately advise the City Manager of the action to add extra labor or equipment.
- d. World Sailfish may utilize public restrooms and agrees to have the public toilets attended, pressure washed, cleaned and provide tissue and towels or World sailfish may provide portable toilets at their cost including a premises cost if they are located outside of the demised area.
- e. World Sailfish will provide trash receptacles for use during the events. World Sailfish shall pay costs for the pick-up and disposal charges for the referenced trash receptacles. Cardboard trash receptacles are not permitted. In each instance that the sponsoring organization closes a street, it shall provide additional garbage cans.
- f. World Sailfish will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, which provides that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrel will be used and that they be placed side by side.
- g. World Sailfish shall not utilize electric services and will depend solely on generated power for its use.

# 6. Security Deposit

World Sailfish agrees to provide a security deposit in the amount of \$5000 at least thirty (30) days prior to the event each year for the faithful performance of all repairs necessary due to damage caused by World Sailfish, it's agents, employees, invitees. The parties agree to walk through and inspect the premises before and after the event to confirm exact condition of the premises and any necessary repairs. World Sailfish shall have the right to make any repairs as determined by the inspection within 90 days thereof. In the event that there is no damage the City will refund the security deposit within ten (10) business days of the inspection.

# 7. Insurance and Indemnity Requirements.

World Sailfish shall:

a. Provide comprehensive liability insurance insuring itself and City against all claims of damages or injury to persons or property arising for any reason as a result of the

activities associated with events permitted by City. The insurance policy shall be written by a solvent insurance company in good standing and shall provide minimum coverage of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence and Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) aggregate and in the event that alcohol is being served and/or sold One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) in liquor liability. This policy shall show City as an additional named insured and a copy shall be provided to the Special Events Section of the City Manager's Office no later than three weeks before the event.

b. World Sailfish agrees to protect, defend, indemnify, save and hold harmless the City of Key West, all of its Departments, Agencies, Boards and Commissions, its officers, agents, servants and employees, including volunteers, from and against any and all claims, demands, expense and liability arising out of injury or death to any person or the damage, loss of destruction of any property which may occur or in any way grow out of any act or omission of the World Sailfish, its agents, servants, and employees, or any and all costs, expense and/or attorney fees incurred by the City as a result of any claim, demands, and/or causes of action except of those claims, demands, and/or causes of action arising out of the negligence of the City, all its Departments, Agencies, Boards and Commissions, its officers, agents, servants and employees, World Sailfish agrees to investigate, handle, respond to, provide defense for and defend any such claims, demand, or suit at its sole expense and agrees to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto, even if it (claims, etc.) is groundless, false or fraudulent. Nothing in this indemnification is intended to act as a waiver of the City's sovereign immunity rights, including those provided under section 768.28, Florida Statues. This indemnification shall survive the expiration or termination of this Agreement. In the event that any action or proceeding is brought against the City by reason of such claim or demand, World Sailfish shall, upon written notice from the City, resist and defend such action or proceeding by counsel satisfactory to the City. World Sailfish shall defend at its own expense to and through appellate, supplemental or bankruptcy proceeding, or to provide for such defense, at the City's option, any and all claims of liability and all suits and actions of every name and description covered above which may be brought against the City whether performed by World Sailfish, or by persons employed or used by World Sailfish.

# 8. Assignment and Hypothecation

This Agreement is not transferable or assignable, except as provided by Resolution of the Key West City Commission.

# 9. Default, Remedies

In the event that World Sailfish fails to comply with the terms of this agreement, the City shall have the right to terminate the Agreement upon thirty days written notice which shall be delivered pursuant to Section 11 hereof.

### 10. Termination.

Either party may terminate this agreement by giving the other party written notice within 30 days of the end of the event each year.

# 11. Independent Contractor

World Sailfish is an independent contractor with respect to the City. No employee or agent of World Sailfish shall be entitled to the wages or benefits of an employee of the City of Key West.

### 12. Notice

All notices, demands, or other writings in this Agreement provided to be given or made or sent, or which may be given or made or sent, by either party to this Agreement to the other, shall be deemed to have been fully given or made or sent when made in writing and received by hand delivery or Certified mail with sufficient postage pre-paid thereon to carry it to its addressed destination and addressed as follows:

The address to which any notice, demands, or other writing may be given or made or sent to any party mentioned above may be changed by written notice.

# 13. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement shall be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall not be impaired thereby, but such remaining provisions shall be interpreted and enforced so to achieve, as near as may be, the purpose of this Agreement to the extent permitted by law.

# 14. Governing Law.

This Agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the

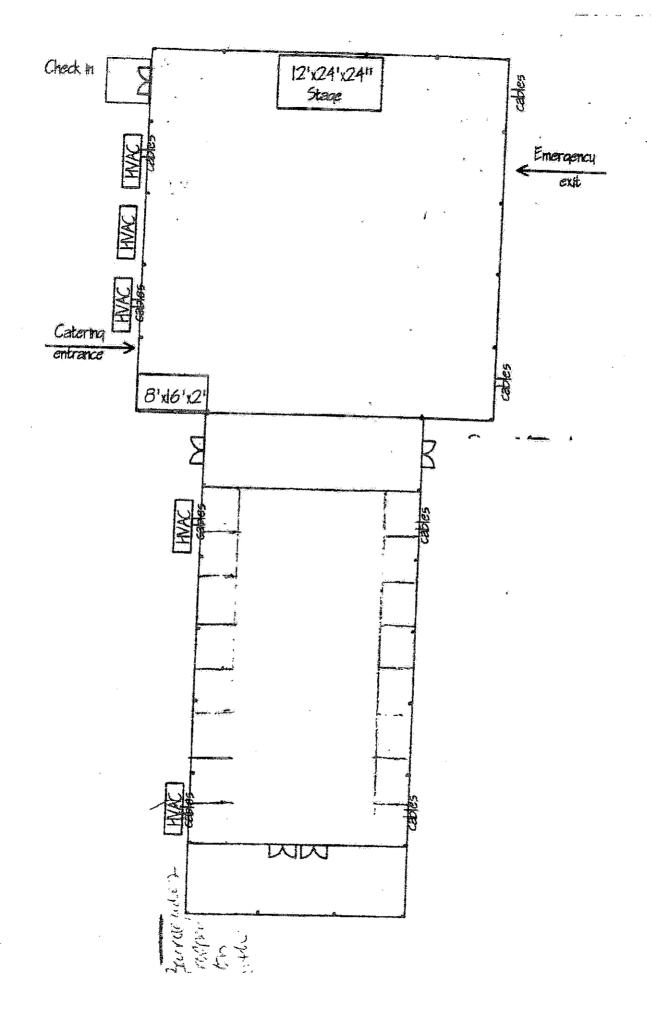
State of Florida.

# 15. Entire Agreement.

### ORDINANCE NO. 02-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "AMUSEMENTS AND ENTERTAINMENT" BY AMENDING ARTICLE II PERTAINING TO SPECIAL EVENTS: AMENDING SECTION 6-26 TO REQUIRE A DOWN PAYMENT ON THE COST OF CITY SERVICES, TO ALLOW FOR INTEREST ON LATE PAYMENTS, AND TO INCREASE THE COST WAIVER TO \$1,000.00; ADDING SECTION 6-27 TO RESTRICT PLACEMENT OF FOOD, BEVERAGE AND MERCHANDISE BOOTHS: AMENDING SECTION 6-56 TO REQUIRE THE APPLICATION TO LIST AN EMERGENCY CONTACT PERSON; AMENDING SECTION 6-57 TO ESTABLISH A MINIMM NON-PROFIT SHARE FOR SPECIAL EVENTS IN WHICH A STREET IS CLOSED; AMENDING SECTION 6-58 TO PROVIDE THAT MAJOR FESTIVAL SPONSORS MAKE APPLLICATION SIX MONTHS IN ADVANCE AND APPROVE CERTAIN SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; ADDING SECTION 6-61 PERTAINING TO HANDICAP-ACCISSIBLE BATHROOM FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The City Commission finds that a revision to the regulations governing special events and street closures would promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That section 6-26 of the Code of Ordinances is herby amended as follows:

Sec. 6-26. Payment for city services.

- (a) The organizer or sponsor of any festival, street fair, fair, carnival, athletic event, contest, competition, parade, fundraiser, rally, boat or car race or other special event which requires city authorization, whether by administrative permit or city commission approval, and which requires the provisions of additional or extraordinary support services by police, fire, administrative, or other city departments in order to maintain order or safety or to escort participants shall pay to the city the cost of such services. A down payment of ten percent (10%) of the costs, as estimated by the city manager, shall be made to the city either by certified check or credit card at least ten (10) days prior to the event.
- (b) The city manger shall establish a cost schedule for additional or extraordinary support services for the events referred to in subsection (a) of this section, which schedule shall be subject to approval of the city commission. The city manager is authorized to provide reasonable terms for time and manner of payment. If the event sponsor fails to pay the full costs at the time determined by the city manager or, if no such deadline is established, then within thirty (30)days after the event the city may impose an interest charge on the amount due at the rate of one and one half percent (1½%) per month.
- (c) The city commission may grant special exceptions to this section for cause shown upon the public record.
- (d) The first \$500.00 \$1,000.00 of costs as specified in subsection (a) of this section may be waived for any organizer or sponsor which has qualified as a tax-exempt nonprofit organization according to state of federal law. Acceptance of this waiver by such sponsor shall render the event a public accommodation subject to the human rights provision of the section 38-225.
- (e) Any nonprofit organization accepting the waiver provided for by subsection (d) of this section shall, within 90 days following the special event, submit to the city commission an accounting of expenses and revenues incurred and generated during the event.

Section 2. That section 6-27 is herby added to the Code of Ordinances as follows: Sec. 6-27. Food, beverage and merchandise booths.

No booth or stall set up for a special event and serving any amount or type of food and/or beverage, or selling merchandise, shall be placed directly in front of, or within five (5) feet of the property line of a restaurant or a bar or a retail store (selling primarily the same or similar merchandise), unless the owner of the restaurant, the bar or the store consents. This section shall not apply to major festivals as defined in section 6-58.

Section 3. That section 6-56 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows: Sec. 6-56, Application.

(a) Except as provided in section 6-58. Aat least 60 days prior to a proposed special event that will result in the closing of a public street, the sponsor shall submit an application to the city manager. An application may be made either by a tax-exempt nonprofit organization (nonprofit) or jointly by a nonprofit and a private or business entity.

(b) If the city manager approves the application, he shall then schedule it for consideration by the city commission. However, if the special event proposes to close only one block, is intended to end prior to 9:00 p.m. on any day of the year, and does not seek either a fee cost waiver or a noise exemption, the city manager may give final approval to the application.

(c) Each application shall include the name of a sponsor's contact person and that person's 24-hour telephone number(s), in case of emergency.

Section 4. That section 6-57 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows: Sec. 6-57. Donation of percentage of revenue to nonprofit organization.

(a) A major festival is a special event of regional impact. Major festivals are: FancyFantasy Fest, Hemingway Days, Goombay Festival, Conch Republic Celebration, the Poker Run, the Valentine's Day event for Wesley House, the Red Ribbon event at Mango's Mangoes, and such other special events as may be added or subtracted by resolution of the city commission. Private persons or business entities who sponsor major festivals are not required to provide finds to a non-profit organization per section 6-57. An application for a major festival must be received in the city manager's office at least six (6) months in advance of the scheduled event. Have a non-profit coapplicant of to provide a percentage of revenues to a charitable cause.

(b) A business that seeks to sell alcoholic beverages at a major festival pursuant to an APS state license, and which is not a bar or restaurant or other concern that sells alcoholic beverages in the ordinary course of its business, must obtain the written approval of the major festival sponsor and provide such approval to the city of key west.

Section 6 That section 6-61 is hereby added to the Code of Ordinances as follows: Sec. 6-61. Temporary bathroom facilities.

Whenever the sponsor of a special event provides temporary bathroom facilities on the public right-of-way, at least five percent (5%) of those facilities or one of those facilities, whichever is the greater number, shall be accessible to persons which physical disability.

Section 7. If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefore and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this ordinance.

Section 8. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall go into effect on January 1, 2003.

- 1. All Applicant(s) must fill out a City of Key West (City) application form provided to you by the Office of the City Manager.
- 2. Application(s) for special event(s) must be in the Office of the City Manager 60 days prior to the event.
- 3. Application(s) must provide comprehensive liability insurance insuring itself and the City against all claims of damages or injury to persons or property arising for any reason as a result of the activities associated with the special event permitted by the City. The insurance policy shall be written by a solvent insurance company in good standing and shall provide a minimum of \$1 million general liability. The policy shall show the City of Key West as an additional named insured.

- 4. # ATTACHMENT B: GENERAL CONDITIONS

- The Licensor hereby grants to the Licensee the right to use the premises or facilities described in item 3, together with the necessary rights of ingress and egress.
- b. This License shall be effective for the period stated in item 2 and is revocable at any time without notice at the option and discretion of the Licensor or its duly authorized representative.
- C. The use shall be limited to the purposes specified herein. Licensor does not warrant or represent that the property is safe or suitable for the purpose for which Licensee intends to use it, and Licensee assumes all risks in its use.
- d. This License shall be neither assignable nor transferable by the Licensee.
- 6. If utilities and services are furnished to the Licensee during License period, the Licensee shall reimburse the Licensor for the cost thereof as determined by the Licensor in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations.
- f. The Licensee, at its own cost and expense shall protect, maintain, and keep in good order, the premises or facilities licensed hereby. At the discretion of the Licenser this obligation shall include, but not be limited to, contribution toward the expense of long-ferra maintenance of the premises or facilities, the necessity for which secreted during the period of Licensee's use. The amount of expense to be borne by the Licensee shall be determine by prorating the total expense of the item of long-term maintenance on the basis of fractional use by the Licensee. This fractional part of the total expense shall be prorated further if the item of long-term maintenance did not accrue in its entirety during the Licensee's use. Each policy of insurance against loss or damage to City of Key West properly shall name the Licensee and the City of Key West, as the insured and shall commin a loss payable clause reading substantially as follows: "Loss, if any, under this policy shall be adjusted with (Name of Licensee) and the City of Key West and the proceeds shall be psyable to the City of Key West" In the event that any item or part of the premises or facilities shall require repair, rebuilding or replacement resulting from loss or damage, the risk of which is assumed under this paragraph h, the Licensee shall promptly give notice thereof to the Licensor and, to the extent of its liability as provided in this paragraph, shall, upon demand, either compensate the City of Key West for such loss or damage, or rebuild, replace or repair the item or items of the premises or facilities so lost or damaged, as the Licensor may elect. If the cost of such repair, rebuilding, or replacement exceeds the liability of the Licensee for such loss or damage, the Licensee shall effect such repair, rebuilding or replacement if required so to do by the Licensor and such excess of cost shall be reimbursed to the Licensee by the Licenson. This indemnity shall survive the expiration of this License.
- J. All insurance required by this License shall be in such form, for such periods of time, and with such insurers as the Licensor may require or approve. This warranty shall not apply to commissions psyable by the Licensee upon contracts or sales secured or made through bona fide established commercial or selling agencies maintained by the Licensee for the purpose of securing business.
- In connection with the performance of work under this License, the Licensee agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, or national origin, sex, disability, ancestry, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, marital status, percental status or source of income. The aforesaid provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, ingrading, demotion, or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. - 2. Prior to use of the premises Licensee must provide a \$ \_\_\_\_\_ refundable deposit and a \$ \_\_\_\_\_ nonrefundable payment for use of the property. This payment shall be delivered to the Port office at P.O Box 6434, Key West, FL 33041-6434. All checks shall be made payable to Licensor. Utilities used by Licensee will be charged at current rates. Any additional costs that will be incurred by the City (security, fire protection, public works, Navy, etc.) must be paid to the City to those departments. Assignment of damage cost or noncompliance penalties will be at the discretion of the City of Key West. Additional charges may be made after the activity if required.
- All utility use must be coordinated through Doug Bradshaw. Any modification to utilities to support the activity will be at the sole cost of the Licensee.
- 4. 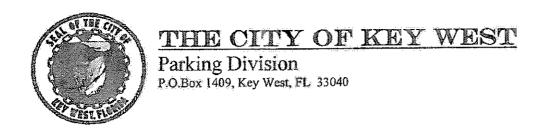

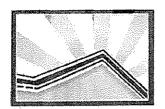

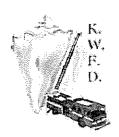
