A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST CARNIVAL CORP TO CONDUCT A JUNETEENTH CARNIVAL AND A PARADE AT THE KEY WEST COFFEE BUTLER AMPHITHEATER FROM 7:00 AM TO 11:00 PM ON SATURDAY, JUNE 19, 2021; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE BARRICADED AREA OF THE FESTIVAL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Key West Carnival Corp. wishes to conduct a Juneteenth Carnival at the Key West Coffee Butler Amphitheater on Saturday, June 19, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law.”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City”

SECTION 3. the Key West Carnival Corp is hereby granted permission to conduct the event during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Key West Carnival Corp. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That the Key West Carnival Corp. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcohol beverages to persons 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. That the Key West Carnival Corp. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That the rental fee for the use of the Coffee Butler Key West Amphitheater is Five hundred dollars (500.00) and should be paid before the event.

SECTION 8. That the parade will begin at 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. starting at the Key West Coffee Butler Amphitheater, going towards Angela Street, to Thomas Street, to Fleming Street to Whitehead Street to Front Street to Duval Street then to South Street to Whitehead to Catherine Street to Thomas Street to Petronia Street then to Fort Street and back to the Key West Coffee Butler Amphitheater to continue the Juneteenth Celebration.

SECTION 9.b That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by the Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the Community.

SECTION 10. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
