A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEDITIOUSLY RE-EVALUATE AND AMEND THE COMPENSATION, TITLE AND JOB DESCRIPTION OF THE VACANT BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN COORDINATOR POSITION TO "MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION COORDINATOR;" RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY MANAGER MAKE EFFORTS TO HIRE A QUALIFIED PERSON FOR THAT POSITION IN A TIMELY MANNER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West has a high percentage of citizens who commute by bicycle, and a high number of bicycle and pedestrian injuries as well; and

WHEREAS, increasing a transportation mode shift away from motor vehicles is a key element to many of the actions in the City's 2009 Climate Action Plan and the newly updated 2013 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the position of Bicycle/Pedestrian Coordinator has been vacant for nearly six months; and

WHEREAS, the City's Parking and Alternative Transportation Committee has recommended that City management make a priority of hiring a Multimodal Transportation Coordinator, to improve the City's progress toward alleviating traffic congestion, bicycle

safety, and improving multimodal transportation infrastructure;
and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby recommended to re-evaluate and amend the compensation, title and job description of the vacant "Bicycle/pedestrian Coordinator" to "Multimodal Transportation Coordinator."

Section 2: That the City Manager is recommended to make efforts to hire a qualified Multimodal Transportation Coordinator in an expeditious manner.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
