A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT TO CONCH REPUBLIC SEAFOOD COMPANY FOR THE 34<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL KEY WEST POWERBOAT WEEK AT THE 631 GREENE STREET PARKING LOT AND ADJACENT GRAVEL LOT ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2026, THROUGH SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2026, FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M. (SETUP ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Conch Republic Seafood Company has applied to the City for a Special Event Permit for their event "34<sup>th</sup> Annual Key West Powerboat Week" to take place on Wednesday, November 4, 2026, through Sunday, November 8, 2026, from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. at the 631 Greene Street parking lot and adjacent gravel lot; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That In Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or

services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee/contractor acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.

SECTION 3. That Conch Republic Seafood Company is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance.

SECTION 5. There will be amplified sound from an emcee, radio, announcements and music played during the event.

SECTION 6. That Conch Republic Seafood Company will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, and that one (1)

recycling container for every one (1) trash barrel will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That Conch Republic Seafood Company acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
