A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE DISPOSAL OF TWENTY (20) CITY-OWNED VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, twenty City-owned vehicles are no longer operational, and City staff recommends disposal of the vehicles with title conversions to Certificates of Destruction, to ensure that unsafe vehicles are not returned to the streets of Key West; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the disposal of twenty vehicles, as described in the attached vehicle disposal list, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the twenty vehicles shall be sold as one bulk sale, with title conversions to Certificates of Destruction, to the highest bidder.

Section 3: That the City Manager, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to execute all necessary documents.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
