NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

McIntyre was in a loud verbal argument with his girlfriend. When she tried to leave the area via a Conch Connect, McIntyre caused a scene and began pounding on the vehicle. The vehicle drove away and called police. The arguing between McIntyre and his girlfriend generated 3 separate calls for service. McIntyre refused to follow lawful commands and was tensing and pulling away from officers as they attempted to gain control of McIntyre's person. McIntyre was redirected to an elevated planter/landscape area where he continued to tense his body and refused to place his arms behind his back.
