A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ROTARY CLUB OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, INC. TO CONDUCT A FUNDRAISER AT MCCOY INDIGENOUS PARK AND FIREWORKS ON THE EDWARD B. KNIGHT PIER ON JULY 4, 2025; AUTHORIZING FIREWORKS DISPLAY OFF THE EDWARD B. KNIGHT PIER ON JULY 4, 2025 FROM 9:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT MCCOY INDIGENOUS PARK ON JULY 4, 2025 FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. wishes to conduct a fundraiser at McCoy Indigenous Park during the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. and fireworks on the Edward B. Knight Pier during the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, July 4, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable.

Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That the Rotary Club of Key West, Florida, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the Fundraiser on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the City is executed and authorizing up to the budget amount for the expenditure of the pyrotechnic; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances the Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 5. That the Rotary Club of Key West, Florida, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. That the Rotary Club of Key West, Florida, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
