-- Shanola Webb Arrest Narrative:

On February 25, 2023, at 2005 hours, Ofc. R. Roscoe and I (Ofc. S. Ham) were dispatched to 2120 N Roosevelt Blvd (Popeye's), reference a trespasser.

Upon arrival, I made contact with management of Popeye's that advised there was a black female inside, wearing a small dress. Management at Popeye's asked for the female to be issued a trespass warning for the property. Management stated that the female's dress was short and would reveal her sexual organs anytime she bent over or sat down. Management stated this was the third time the female has come in with the dress on and her sexual organs keep coming out. Management stated they have families and children that come into the establishment and because the revealing nature of the dress is why they wanted her trespassed.

I located the female on the west side of the property near Popeye's exit door. I advised the female for the reason of us being called to the location and that management wished to have her trespassed. The female refused to provide her identification and began acting irate by yelling curse words and causing a scene. I advised the female that failure to provide her identification was a violation of F.S.S. 843.02 resisting officers without violence. She made a comment that she was going to contact her police friends. The female then made a call to 911 and left the phone down by her side, not acknowledging the dispatchers on the line. The female made that first call to 911 at 2014 hours and stayed on the line with KWPD dispatch for 96 seconds before disconnecting. I advised the female again that we needed her identification in order to issue her the trespass warning and she began looking through her wallet for it. The female stopped a few times to continue yelling slurs at Ofc. R. Roscoe and me.

The female then provided her ID card out of Texas to Ofc. Roscoe and was identified as Shanola Webb. Shanola then made another 911 call to KWPD dispatch at 2017 hours for a duration of 41 seconds and held up the emergency line without speaking to the dispatcher. KWPD dispatch advised Ofc. Roscoe and I that Shanola had contacted them again and was holding up the line. I advised Shanola that 911 was an emergency line used for emergency purposes. Shanola would not listen to Ofc. Roscoe and I. Shanola continued yelling slurs at the both of us until her information came back valid and clear through KWPD dispatch. I provided Shanola with her ID card back and advised her again of her trespass warning from the property. Shanola packed up her belongings as she continued to yell and scream while exiting the property.

Shanola walked across N Roosevelt Blvd and stood on the sidewalk. I went to advise the Popeye's manager that Shanola was being issued the trespass warning and if she was to return to contact the KWPD immediately because of her irate behavior. While speaking with management for Popeye's, KWPD dispatch advised Ofc. Roscoe and I that Shanola had contacted them two more times through 911. One was at 2024 hours for 21 seconds and held up the line without saying anything. The final call to 911 was at 2026 hours for 156 seconds, where she did speak to one of the dispatchers that had nothing to do with a emergency.

Ofc. Roscoe and I, drove our patrol vehicles across N Roosevelt Blvd to confront Shanola. I approached Shanola and removed the large stick she had in her shopping cart out of her reach. I advised Shanola that she had just contacted 911 again and she stated no. Shanola stated she was calling 911 to get a report so she could sue Popeye's establishment. I grabbed Shanola by her left wrist and told her to place her hands behind her back. Shanola immediately tried to pull away and tuck her left arm into her chest. I pulled Shanola's left arm back out and went to place it behind her back while giving her multiple commands to place her hands behind her back and stop pulling away. Shanola continued to pull away and try to bring her hand back into her chest. I used a modified straight arm takedown on Shanola by pulling her left arm to the ground while using a leg sweeping motion. Shanola landed on her right side and continued pulling her arm into her chest and refuse to lay on her stomach. Ofc. Roscoe arrived with me and gained control of Shanola's right hand and positioned it behind her back. I handcuffed Shanola and rolled her onto her side in a recovery position. I asked Shanola if she sustained any injuries and she continued stating that she is

suing. Shanola stated she knows her constitutional rights and she did not do anything. I advised Shanola that she contacted 911 four times and that was a misuse of emergency services. Shanola stated, "whatever mother fucker, I'm going to get out of jail and fight you, I'm going to fight you until your dead". I advised Shanola that she was making threats now towards law enforcement and she just continued with saying she was going to fight me until I'm dead. I sat Shanola upright into a seated position and waited for Sgt. N. Revoredo to arrive on scene and evaluate Shanola for a response to resistance. Shanola sustained a small abrasion on her left thumb but did not require any medical attention.

I transported Shanola to Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

Upon arrival to Monroe County Detention Center, I was advised by intake deputies that Shanola has multiple IDs from different states and multiple social security numbers. The intake deputy advised me that Shanola is a convicted felon and has not registered in Monroe County. A routine history check in our system showed that Shanola has been in the City of Key west since at least February 14, 2023. Shanola had two prior encounters with KWPD officers. The first encounter was on February 14, 2023 at 2338 N Roosevelt Blvd (Taco Bell) and Shanola was issued a trespass warning as well as a camping warning (Cad #230450020). Shanola was also issued a trespass warning on February 17, 2023, by Ofc. T. Moore (Cad # 230480145). Shanola has been in the city of Key West and has failed to register as a convicted felon within 48 hours of her arrival. Shanola was convicted of grand theft on 10-04-2015, in Casclos Angeles, Santa Monica, CA.

Shanola intentionally made 4 calls to 911, two while standing with Ofc. Roscoe and I and held up the emergency line for a total of 137 seconds without saying anything to dispatchers. After Shanola was issued her trespass warning she stood across the street from the location and made two more phone calls to 911, totaling 177 seconds, without an emergency. Shanola was advised that misuse of 911 was a violation of Florida statute and only to be used in an emergency prior to her two final calls. There is probable cause to believe that Shalona was in violation of F.S.S. 365.172-14 Misuse 911.

I went to handcuff Shanola and advised her to place her hands behind her back and Shanola physically pulled away and refused to comply. Shanola continued to pull away and was escorted to the ground using a modified straight arm take down. While on the ground Shanola failed to roll on to her stomach and attempted to tuck her arms into her chest to prevent Ofc. Roscoe and I from handcuffing her. There is probable cause to believe that Shanola was in violation of F.S.S. 843.02 Resist officer without violence.

Shanola had been in Monroe County and the City of Key West for at least 11 days and has failed to register as a convicted felon. KWPD officer's have had to encounters with Shanola and issued her warnings for trespassing on February 14 and 17 of 2023. There is probable cause to believe Shanola was in violation of F.S.S. 775.13-5A Failure to register as a convicted felon.

My Axon BWC and Axon Fleet were activated and uploaded.

On 02/25/2023 I was dispatched to 2120 N. Roosevelt Blvd for a suspicious incident.

When I arrived, Ofc. Ham was outside the business with Shanola Webb issuing her a trespass warning from the property. Webb became highly agitated and began yelling at Ofc. Ham and I. She then stated she was going to call her police. KWPD dispatch inform me over the radio that Webb had called 911 and was tying up an emergency line. Webb was educated about the misuse of 911 and told she was trespassed from the property. Webb gathered her belongings and left the property.

Webb went across the street and called 911 four more times. KWPD dispatch informed Ofc. Ham and I that Webb had called 911 again. Ofc. Ham and I then went to speak with Webb about the issue again.

Ofc. Ham arrived just prior to me and had already began interacting with Webb. As I approached, Ofc. Ham had Webb on the ground and was attempting to handcuff her. Webb was lying on the ground with her left arm under her torso. Ofc. Ham was attempting to gain control of Webb's arm to apply a handcuff. I instructed Webb to give me her hand as I attempted to remove it from under her torso. Webb continued to refuse to remove her arm from under her torso. I was eventually able to remove Webb's right arm from under her torso, and gain control of it. Webb's arms were then placed behind her back, and she was handcuffed. She was then searched and placed into the back of Ofc. Ham's patrol car.

My BWC was activated and recorded the above interaction.
