On Friday, April 13, 2018 at 3:38 AM, I was dispatched as backup with Officer Torrecillas to 324 Margaret Street in reference to an intoxicated subject trespassing on someone's front porch.

Michael Rogers was passed out on the front porch swing at 324 Margaret Street. We woke Michael up and attempted to find out where he lives so we could get him home. Michael insisted he was at his house. When asked where he was, he told us he was at an address in Georgia.

Officer Torrecillas determined Michael needed to be taken into custody under the Marchman Act. Michael kept asking why he was being arrested even though we explained to him, multiple times, he was being taken into protective custody due to his level of intoxication. Michael told us CNN was filming and we would be on the news in the morning. Michael said he drove down to Key West from Georgia because he had a trial in the morning. He also told us his attorney told him he would be arrested when he came to Key West.

Michael resisted our efforts to get him into the back seat of Officer Torrecillas' patrol car. Michael refused to put his legs in the car. I attempted to push his legs in the car with my foot with negative results. Officer Torrecillas went to the other side of the car to pull Michael into the back seat. Once his legs were inside the car I shut the door and went to the other side of the car. Michael had pushed against the closed door with his legs, causing his head and shoulders to be outside the other side of the car. We attempted to push his upper body into the car and he stiffened his posture to keep us from getting him into the car. After several failed attempts trying to push Michael into the back seat of the car, I drive-stunned him twice, once in the back and one in the side. Even after the drive-stunning, Officer Torrecillas and I still had to push Michael into the back of the car.

My decision to drive-stun Michael was based on his non-compliance and that he was flailing around in the back seat putting us and himself in harms way.

I requested Sergeant Castillo come to the scene reference a response to resistance.

I followed Officer Torrecillas to the emergency room at Lower Keys Medical Center to get Michael medically cleared due to an abrasion sustained to his left cheek. Michael continued to be verbally non-compliant while at the emergency room. He continued to say we would be on CNN in the morning and that he drove 12 hours to Key West from Georgia for a trial in the morning.
