A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE RELOCATION OF THE MALLORY SQUARE PANHANDLING ZONE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS; The City Commission for the City of Key West, after being fully advised of the current issues with the Mallory Square panhandling zone in its current location including harassment of passersby who do not wish to contribute to persons in the current panhandling zone, and excessive litter, and;

WHEREAS, The City Commission for the City of Key West passed ordinance 12-03 wherein any changes to permissible passive panhandling zones can be changed via Resolution, and;

WHEREAS the City Commission for the City of Key West finds that relocating the current Mallory Square panhandling zone to another area within Mallory Square as described herein is a content neutral, regulation that is narrowly tailored to meet a compelling governmental interest in preventing visitors from being solicited by panhandlers unwillingly,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That The City Commission for the City of Key
West resolves to relocate the current permissible passive

panhandling zone from an area currently parallel and immediately	
adjacent to Wall Street to a dedicated space within the Mallory	
Square parking lot more particularly described in Exhibit A,	
attached.	
Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect	
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by	
the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the	
Commission.
