A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(2) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA RATIFYING THE EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES FROM REYNOLDS CONSTRUCTION OF FLORIDA, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$93,829.38 TO SUPPRESS THE TWO (2) DEEP INJECTION WELLS AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS/ADJUSTMENTS, UPON THE CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West owns, operates, and maintains two (2) deep injection wells for the disposal of treated effluent at the Richard A Heyman Environmental Protection Facility. The IW-1 and IW-2 injection wells were constructed in 2000 and 2006, respectively. Replacement of the valves, meters, and instrumentation controls is necessary to maintain operation of the deep injection wells; and

WHEREAS, Reynolds Construction of Florida, LLC has been employed to replace the valves, meters and instrument controls and recondition the wellhead piping. Suppression of backflow pressure in the deep injection wells is necessary to replace the valves and must be done by a State of Florida Water Well Contractor. Reynolds Construction of Florida, LLC has subcontracted suppression of the wells to Florida Drilling, a State of Florida Water Well Contractor; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(2) of the City's Code of Ordinances allows the City Manager to make emergency procurement of commodities where the cost exceeds \$50,000.00 when there exists a clear and present threat to public health, property, welfare, safety or other substantial loss to the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the emergency procurement of services from Reynolds Construction of Florida, LLC in the amount of \$93,829.38 to suppress the City's two (2) deep injection wells at the Wastewater Treatment Facility is hereby ratified.

Section 2. That the funds for the replacement of deep well valves, meters, and instrument controls has been budgeted in 4013504 5356500, SE35042301 and the budget transfer within the sewer fund is hereby approved/ratified.

Section 3. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary documents and budget transfers/adjustments, upon the consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
