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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF SIX SOLAR STREET LIGHTS FROM RAYBRO/CED-KEY WEST IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$77,921.61 IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(4)(b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, there are a number of existing streetlights with electrical service feeds on Greene Street that are out of service and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified a unique system that uses a solar panel wrapped pole with historical base that could eliminate the need for reconstruction of underground electrical conduit and sidewalk, and allow the City to test out a new solar powered technology; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code Section 2-797(4)(b), the City Manager finds that exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from the competitive bid requirements in the best interests of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the procurement of six solar streetlights from RAYBRO/CED-KEY WEST, in an amount not to exceed \$77,921.61, in the best interests of the City, pursuant to Sections 2-797(4)(b) of the code of ordinances, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funds for this purchase are authorized to be transferred from Infrastructure Fund Reserves Account 101-1900-519-9803 to the Gas Tax Fund Account 102-4101-541-6300. Any related budget adjustments or transfers are hereby approved.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.
