A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, REJECTING THE BID RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #12-020, FOR CRUISE SHIP PASSENGER SHUTTLE SERVICE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-834 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the sole response to ITB #12-020 included modifications which rendered it non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, City staff anticipates a new lease with the U.S.

Navy for the Mole Pier area will be negotiated and become effective

upon the expiration of the current lease in June, 2013; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid received in response to ITB #12-020, for Cruise Ship Passenger Shuttle Service is rejected pursuant to city code of ordinances section 2-834.

Section 2: That City staff is hereby authorized to negotiate an agreement for cruise ship passenger shuttle service at the Navy Mole Pier to terminate no more than six months after the commencement of the new Navy Mole lease (anticipated to commence in June, 2013), to facilitate the issuance and award of a competitive bid for cruise ship passenger shuttle service in conformance with that new lease.
